

14. History:


The Passmore House stands on in-lots 89 and 90 of the original town plat. The property was bought by Benjamin Passmore in 1843, probably because it adjoined his blacksmith's shop. Later owners used the house as a warehouse and its condition deteriorated. It was restored by Mrs. D.M. Hutton and her daughter Jane Bird Hutton after their acquisition of the property in 1960.



45. Description and House Plan:

The Passmore House is a two-story, three bay structure with a side passage entrance. The house was built with a two-story frame ell extending to the rear. Because of its deteriorated condition, the ell was removed during restoration in the 1960's. The windows are six over six. The doorway contains a two-paneled door, four-light sidelights, and a two-light transom. The brick in the facade is common bond with a header course every eighth row. The original interior woodwork has been retained and features drip moldings around the doors and wide baseboards. A one-story brick garage has been added on the west, and a one-room deep addition added on the north and east sides.

The additions, though numerous, are of a scale and material sympathetic to the original house. They do not obscure the orginal exterior detailing or design of the house as it is seen from the street.



Statement of Significance

The Benjamin Passmore House is significant under Criterion C for the period 1843 as an example of how a side passage house was ornamented with elements of the Greek Revival style such as an entablature at the doorway and drip moldings on the interior.

Verbal Boundary Justification

The boundary was chosen to follow the property lines historically associated with the Passmore House.

The nominated area contains one contributing property.
