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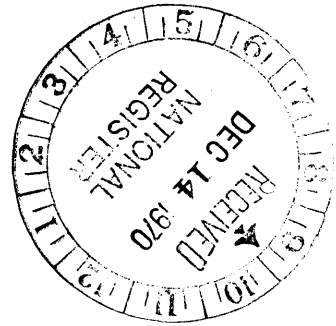

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

One story adobe building in good condition, completed circa 1854- restored in 1939. An fine example of a ranchere's residence. It has thick adobe walls - shake roof Most of the building appears in good condition - some modification from the original, But within the early period design, Has good environmental attributes; is furnished and open to the public.

Today the Palomares Adobe stands in a 20 acre park facing Arrow Highway at the north end of Orange Grove Avenue, the parcel being about 600 feet in width and running north to the Southern Pacific Railroad right of way.

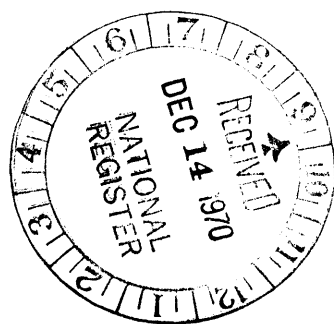

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Don Ignacio Palomares obtained Rancho San Jose De Arriba on March 19, 1837. A house built by him in 1837 and another in 1854 still stands. The latter is described in this petition. This adobe besides being the residence of Don Ignacio, became a popular stage station and tavern. For many years it stood deserted and neglected following which it was restored, ultimately being opened by the Historical Society of Pomona Valley. Today it is one of the finest examples of its kind in California.
