One source feels that this was a Hiltonfarm and another that it was a Goodale. Have not had time to check this out. The son of its owner feels that it was built around 1715 or 1720 as he feels Zachariah Goodale was clearing land as early as 1699. Due to Indian conflicts homes were not built inland until early 1700's. *
