(the present Adams Ladies Club)

Commercial Hotel, proprietor, John Denton...later owned by Andrew L. and
Bessie M. Ingalls. (Property was sold to Adams Community Church)

Hardware and Implements owned by Stanford L. Burrell, also Justice of the Peace.
Later owned by Blakes who sold groceries and candy.

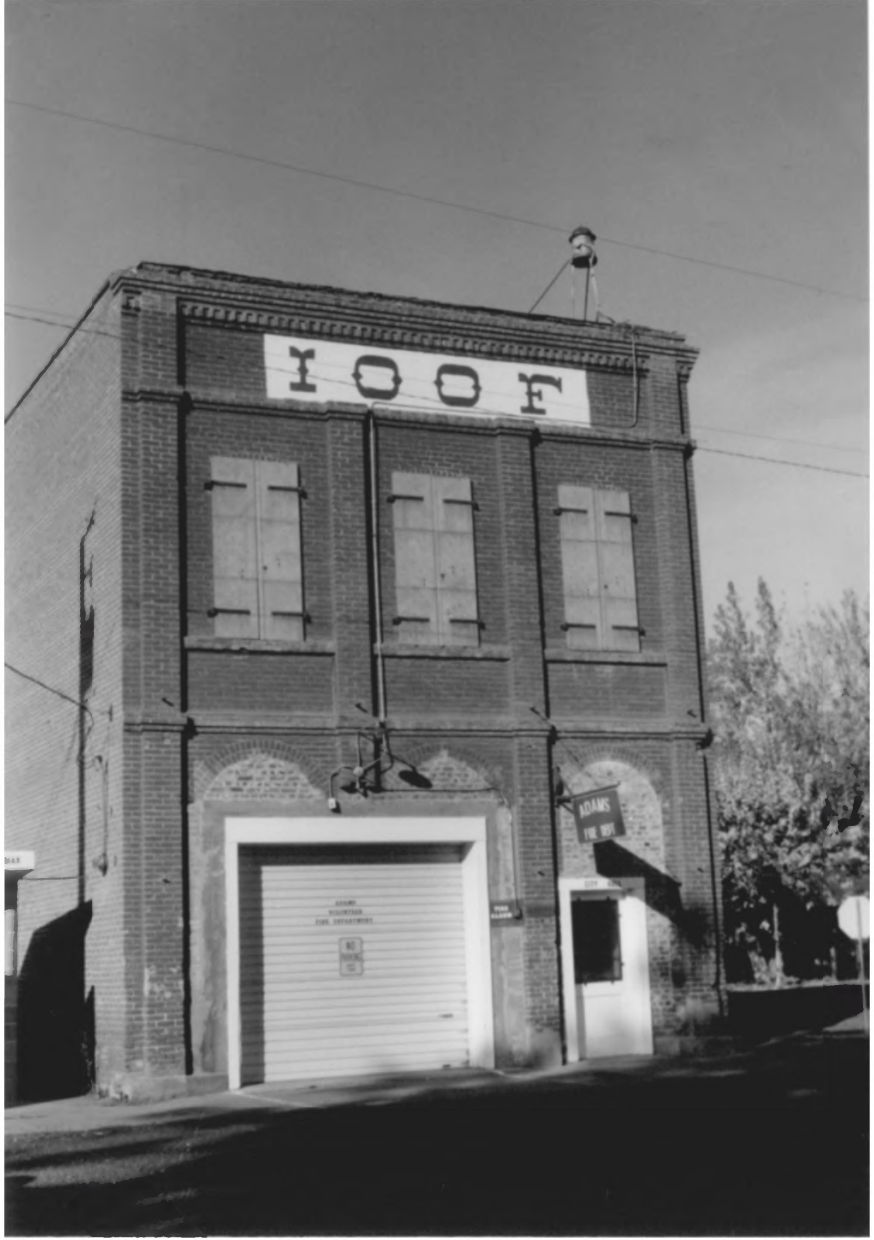
