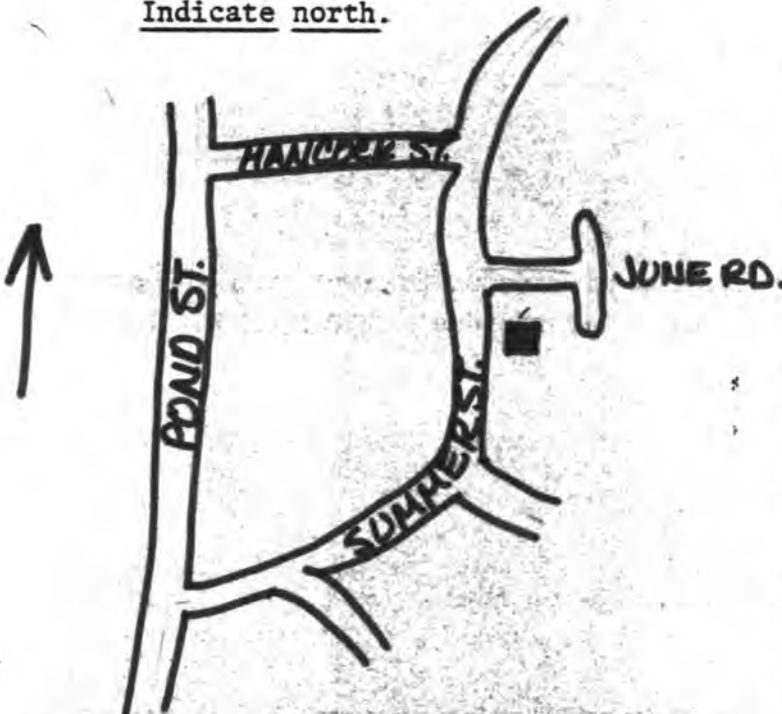

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE (describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within community)

The David Kenney House is a well preserved example of a modest mid-nineteenth century worker's house. Constructed ca. 1850, it is an asymmetrical, one room deep house enclosed by a pitched roof with a center chimney. It is sheathed in clapboards with simple cornerboards and fascia. Windows have simple frames and contain 2/2 sash. The off-center entry is protected by a bracketed hood. The house faces west on Summer Street on large, hilly lot.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE (explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community)

The David Kenney House possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, and workmanship. It is significant as a well preserved example of a modest shoemaker's house. Possessing associations with Stoneham's major theme and period, it meets criterion A of the National Register of Historic Places.

This was the David Kenney property as appears on the 1858 and 1874 maps in 1858, 1874, and 1889. Kenney listed his occupation as a laborer. The house is a well preserved example of a worker's house of the 1840's, with modest Greek Revival detailing. Scroll sawn brackets were added at the entrance at a later date.

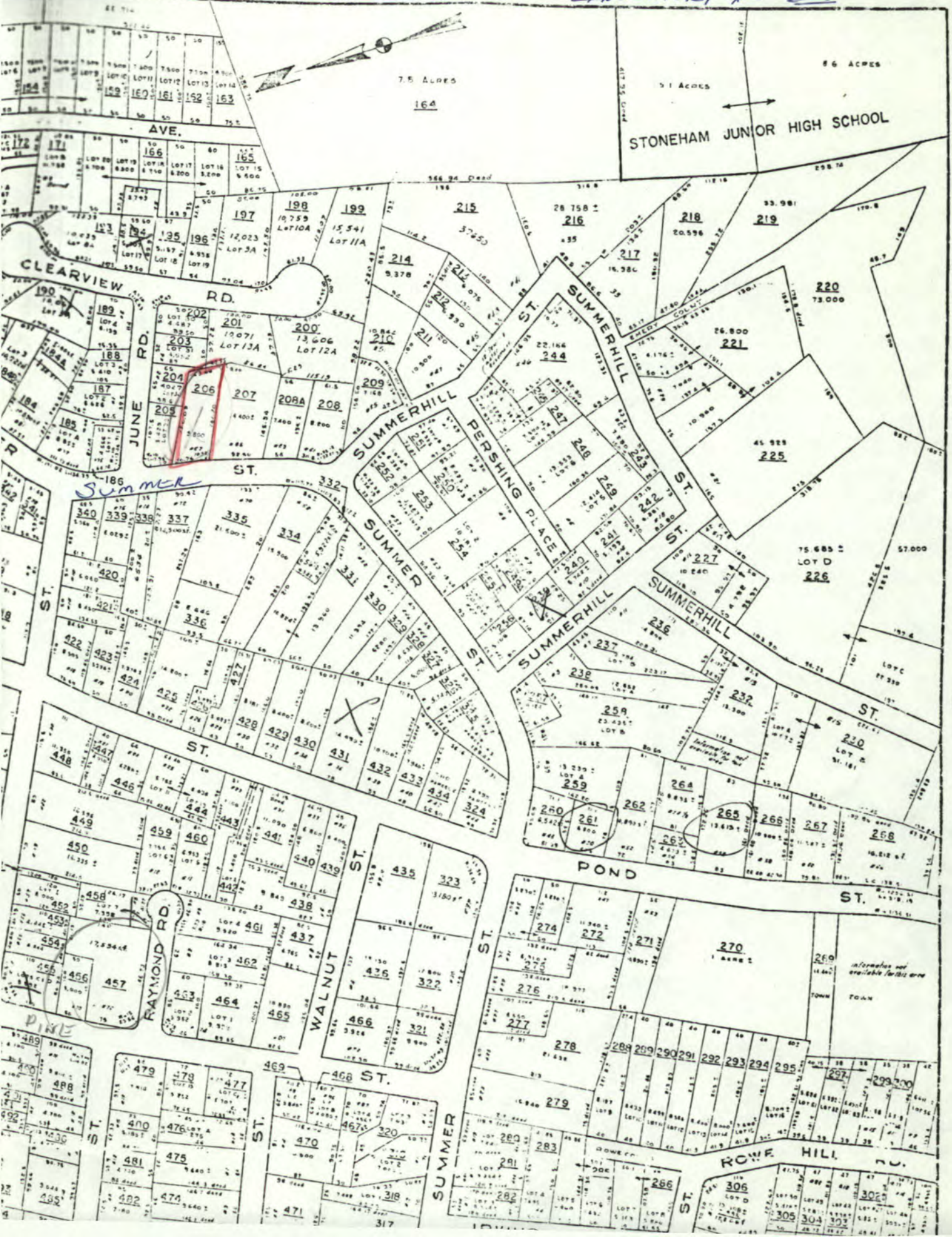
