

THEMATIC NATIONAL REGISTER NOMINATION - GEORGIA COURTHOUSES

Located on a square away from the center of town, the Irwin County Courthouse, constructed of blond brick, has four (4) tetrastyle pedimented facades with Corinthian cement columns. Quoined pavilions flank the facades and pilasters decorate the rear on either side of the doorways. The doorways themselves have new steel and glass doors. Atop the hipped roof is a domed clock tower with four hooded clocks.

An addition has been made at the rear of the building. The entire structure is in a poor state of repair, exuding an unkempt air. Unsightly wires wrap around the building and several storage shacks have been erected against the main facade. See 7/21/80 added un an entire Stuctural integrity

On the interior, some walls are marble and painted plaster. Floors are a combination of wood, tile, carpeting and marble. The courtroom has an acoustical tile ceiling and paneled walls.
