Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

The Aurland United Norwegian Lutheran Church is no longer actively used for services, but is carefully maintained and is in an excellent state of preservation. The cemetery on the site remains in use. A simple frame rectangle, the church's front facade has a central double door with a window to each side. The side facades have three windows each, while the rear has no openings. The windows are four over four sash with large panes of clear glass. Over the windows are simple pedimented moldings. The interior has a center aisle plan with straight pews to each side. There is no chancel: the altar stands against the rear wall on a raised platform. Painted white and gold, the altar has a Gothic reredos with a large canvas of Christ in Ascension, and is surrounded by a curved communion rail. These altar furnishings are traditional for 19th century and early 20th century Lutheran churches in America and northern Europe. Other furnishings include a simple wood pedestal baptismal font, a Gothic pastor's chair and a reed organ. The original wood burning cast iron stove, still the only source for heat, is placed to one side just in front of the platform. The stovepipe crosses the room to the chimney, which rises in back of the altar. The church stands as it was built in 1903-1905 with no alterations, and contains all of the original furnishings.

Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

The Aurland United Norwegian Lutheran Church is significant in the areas of ethnic history, religion and vernacular architecture. As a well-preserved example of a simple, frame country church, the Aurland Church remains a symbol of Norwegian settlement in Brown County. Formed in 1885, the congregation was founded four years after initial settlement. In 1903 when the congregants decided to erect a new ediface, they patterned it on their home church in Aurland, Sogn, Norway. Although there is no pictoral record of that church among the records, tradition suggests that details, such as the pediments over the windows, may have been copied from the mother church. Another traditional feature of the church is the cemetery, which borders the building on two sides. The church was used actively until 1953, during which time, no alterations had been made to the church. Despite its simplicity, the church was well made and its furnishings reflect the spirit of its pioneer builders.
