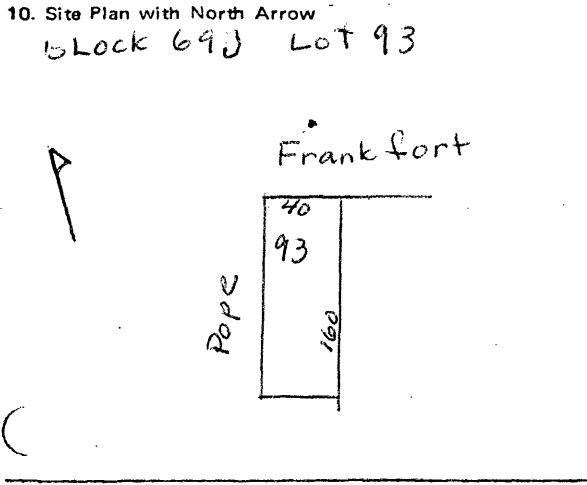

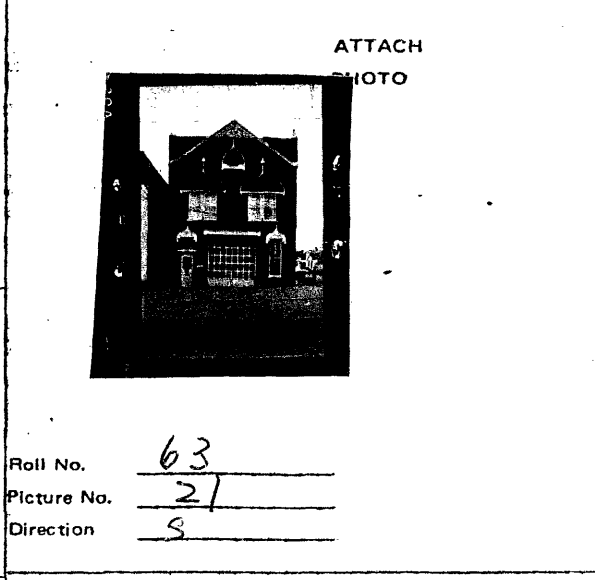

18. Description Hook and Ladder #3 is a two-and-a-half story brick structure in the Gothic Revival style. The first floor has a central over-head door with a stone lintel. This door is flanked by two openings with stone lintels is ogee arched shapes. One opening retains its original form as a window and the other has been changed to a door. The second floor has two paired windows. The windows have arched, stained-glass transoms which are surmounted by brick voussoirs and a stone band (over)

19. History Hook & Ladder #3 was built in 1890. Nothing is known about the contractor, John Greinier & Brothers. The firehouse served the Clifton neighborhood.



20. Significance This structure is an excellent example of the Gothic Revival style in a public building. The structure is reflective of the Victorian styles popular in the Clifton neighborhood.

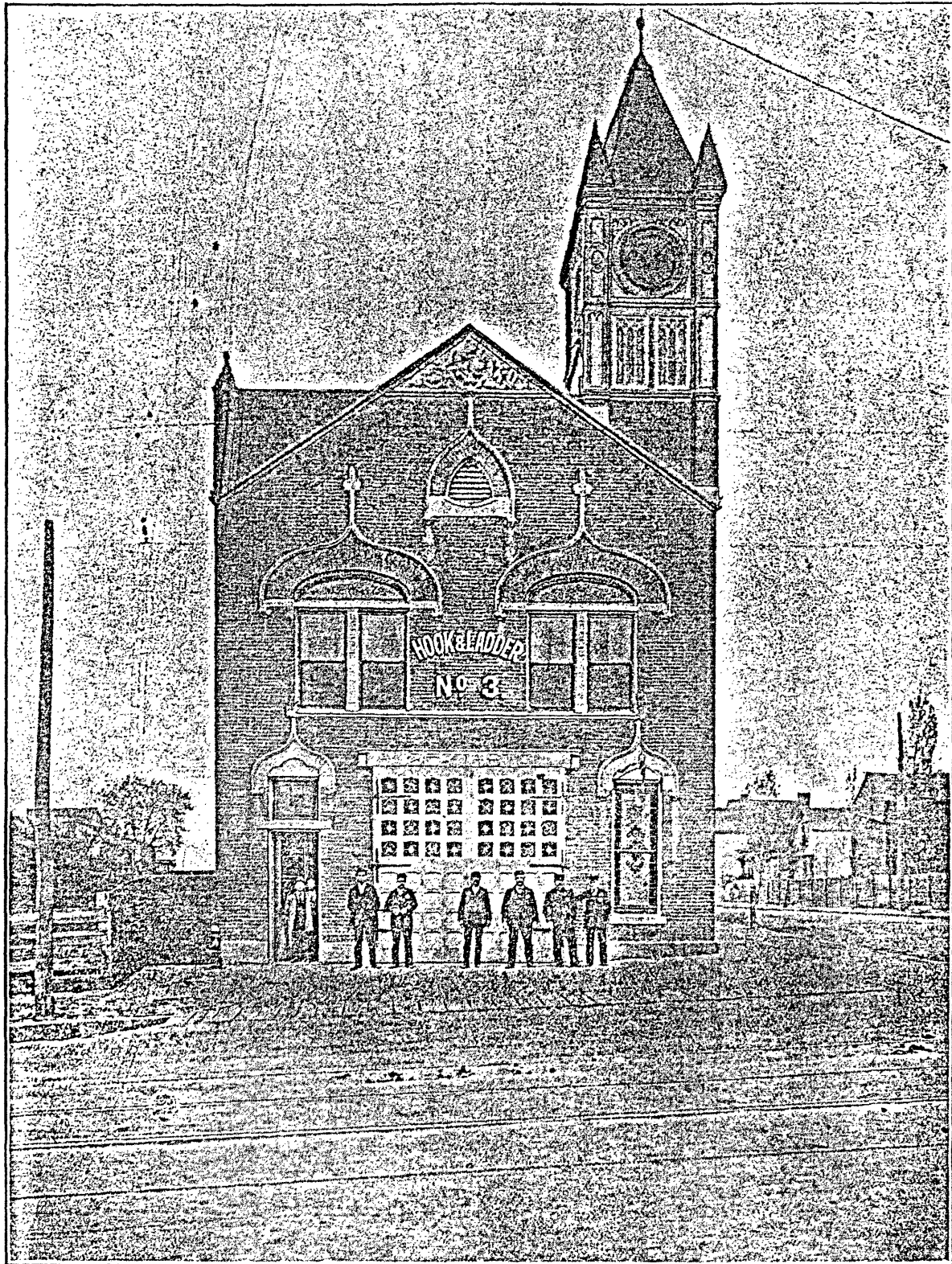
