Residence #1200: Detached dwelling; rectangular plan, 1 1/2-stories, rubble-veneered poured concrete foundation, basement; nailed-wood frame; wood-shingled medium gable roof, left 1/3 of rear slope extends to cover projecting bay, hip-roof wall dormer offset to right on rear elevation, hip-roof dormer offset to left on rear slope of roof, random rubble masonry interior chimneys with vaulted caps offset to right and left on ridgeline. Horizontal rough-sawn 1x12 clapboards extend to eaves on main facade, side elevations, and rear projecting bay, to top of window surrounds on right rear elevation, vertical board and battens on gable ends, on right rear elevation above window level to eaves, on porch pediments, and dormer's cheeks. Windows are eight-over-eight double-hung sash in pairs with mullions, and nine-light single sash. Main entry is slightly offset to left on west-facing main facade, accessed by one straight side step, open flagstone platform; left side of anterior wall is recessed to form porch, covered by front slope of roof, supported by heavy squared-timber posts with long, curved inset brackets support free corner of roof. No decoration. No obvious structural or material alterations to exterior; removable aluminum storm windows affixed.

Non-contributing buildings and structures: Eighteen non-contributing buildings and four non-contributing structures are present on the property. These include a CCC-era residence and attached garage previously determined ineligible for the National Register; four residences built 1948-1963; two bunkhouses built 1957 and 1964; five residential trailers added 1964-1977; a barn and corral built in 1959 and 1974; five warehouses and storage buildings built 1964-1975; three sewer and water structures built 1975-1981; and the main office built 1979.

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The Lake Wenatchee Residence #1200 typifies the construction projects undertaken by the Civilian Conservation Corps and signifies the aid to the local community provided by the emergency work-relief program through employment of youth and experienced craftsmen, purchase of building materials and camp supplies, and personal expenditures of enrollees. The property represents the Forest Service's presence in the locality, as the headquarters for field operation, and denotes, via the physical facilities required to carry out the agency's expanding responsibilities, the critical transition in the Service's development from custodial superintendence to extensive resource management. The Lake Wenatchee Residence #1200 exemplifies the rustic architectural idiom developed by the Forest Service, Pacific Northwest Region, to impart Forest Service identity and to represent its purposes and ideals, and signifies the agency's particular interpretation of a singular expression of early twentieth century American architectural thought. Possessing outstanding qualities of design and execution, the dwelling is a excellent example of an architectural locution invested with special aesthetic and associative values by the agency that created it.

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

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION:

The Lake Wenatchee Residence #1200 is situated on that portion of land lying within the NW1/4SW1/4 Section 13, T.27N., R.16E., Willamette Meridian, in Chelan County, State of Washington, herein described:

Commencing at the sewer cleanout #2 on the Lake Wenatchee Compound Service Road and proceeding 60 feet at 115 degrees to the west elevation of the structure; thence southwest 10 feet to the southwest corner of the building; thence east-southeast 30 feet to the southeast corner of the house; thence continuing east/southeast on the same line 10 feet; thence north/northeast 50 feet at 20 degrees; thence northwest 10 feet at 2980 degrees to the northeast corner of the building; thence northwest 30 feet to the northwest corner of the structure; thence continuing northwest on the same line 10 feet; thence south/southwest 40 feet at 200 degrees to the point of interception from the sewer cleanout line.
