STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			- And Anna Anna Anna

The Swift-Kyle House was built in 1857 by the popular Columbus physican, Dr. Samuel A. Billings, as a wedding gift for his bride, the widow of General Daniel MacDougald. Little is known of the activities taking place in the house during the Billings' five year residence except that the doctor's two daughters were married there.

In 1862 Simon and Frank Rothschild, two brothers from Eufaula, Alabama, bought the house and lived there with their families until the Union forces that occupied the city towards the end of the War Between the States confiscated the house for their headquarters. The Rothschild family was known for its hospitality; wine served Jefferson Davis on his visit to Columbus came from the cellars of their home.

In 1864 Colonel George Parker Swift from Thomaston, Georgia, acquired the house for \$50,000 Confederate dollars and a quantity of osnaburg (a heavy duck material) manufactured in his cotton mill. Shortly after the War ended Colonel and Mrs. Swift moved to Columbus with their seven children. Members of his family lived in the house for eighty-five years, and his descendants still own the property.

Colonel Swift had married Cornelia Adelaide Jewett in 1843 before they moved to Georgia from Massachusetts. Their home had been in the section around Lowell, which was noted for its textile industry. Upon their arrival in Georgia they built the Triune Mills in Upson County, so called because there were three mills. These were among the first cotton mills in Georgia, and were burned by Sherman's Amry on his "March to the Sea."

The move to Columbus proved to be beneficial for Colonel and Mrs. Swift, for Colonel Swift developed the Muscogee Manufacturing Company which became one of the largest manufacturers of cotton towels in the world. It is now a wholly-owned subsidiary of Fieldcrest Mills

Brides of the family for three succeeding generations chose the wedding day, April 19th, of Colonel and Mrs. Swift for their own weddings in this lovely family home: 1883 - Adelaide Swift married James P. Kyle; 1913 -Elizabeth Kyle married Richard P. Spencer, III; 1940 - Elizabeth Kyle Spencer married Gardiner Garrard.

When Colonel Swift died in 1896 he left the house to his children. (continued)

Adelaide Swift Kyle acquired the interest in the house of her brothers and sisters, and lived in it the rest of her life. Her children - Elizabeth Kyle Spencer, Edith Kyle Crawford, and George Swift Kyle - were born and reared in this home. Upon Mrs. Kyle's death in 1938 the house passed to her three children.

In 1941 Edith Kyle married Henry Benning Crawford. Because Mrs. Crawford wanted to live in the house she had lived in most of her life she entered into an agreement with Mr. Crawford: they would live six months of each year in her family home, and the remaining six months of each year in his home. This unusual arrangement worked smoothly for fifteen years.

The Swift-Kyle House remained a private home until 1956 when the widowed Mrs. Crawford envisioned a twentieth century commercial adaptive use for this historic home, and it saw service for awhile as Massey Business College. Today the house continues to enhance Columbus as a facility for three other businesses: The Columbus Travel Bureau; The Flying Needle Tailor Shop; and the offices of the Columbus Rotary Club. The two story century old outbuilding in the rear serves as the artist studio of the noted New York painter Henry Nordhousen when he is in residence in Columbus.

This house, which is still playing a vital role in the community, is located at the intersection of Twelfth Street and Third Avenue. Twelfth Street is the main thoroughfare into downtown Columbus.

In this instance a busy street (Third Avenue) has become an aid to a historic structure for it permits the eye to enjoy the Swift-Kyle House without being overpowered by the visual impact of a modern multi-story business complex, The Ralston Motor Hotel-Georgia Power Company complex. Directly across from the Swift-Kyle House are the well kept buildings and gardens of the Holy Family Catholic Church. Diagonally across the intersection of Twelfth and Third are the lovely buildings and grounds of the First Baptist Church, Columbus' only ante-bellum church structure.

"Progress," however, does endanger the Swift-Kyle House. In the same block, on the same side of the street, but at the other corner is the terminal of a locally owned bus line that serves Fort Benning, Georgia. Any expansion plan of the busline would necessitate utilizing Twelfth Street frontage because of existing property values. Thus, the adjacent Swift-Kyle House is urgently in need of the protection and prestige afforded by the National Register. According to a recently passed Columbus zoning ordinance, any house accepted by the National Register will be given a "Landmark" status locally. This means that all alterations, improvements, partial demolitions, etc., will be subject to review by the local Board of Historic and Architectural Reveiw.

According to Edward W. Neal, a prominent local architect who is vitally interested in historic preservation, this is the only house in the Chattahoochee Valleyarea that is k_{nown} to him that has a portico going around a projected room
