45. Description and House Plan:

One-story, single-cell, dry-stone dependency, ca. 15 x 18 feet, built about 1830-35. Was perhaps the kitchen, but fireplace looks small for cooking (not able to inspect up close). Masonry in irregular courses of fossiliferous limestone, heaviest at corners. Chimney is exterior, centered in south gable end. One door east side, one door north end, one window west side, no attic windows. Chimney top rebuilt with brick. Door has ovolo trim, window has ogee. Inside walls plastered, lathe and plaster ceiling, no chair rail, Greek mantel. Building entirely separate from house.

Located just behind three-bay, center-passage frame Greek Revival house on tooled stone foundation, ca 28 x 45 feet. House has exterior shouldered brick chimneys on each gable end, flanked by square attic windows. Has gabled pediment with four-square wooden columns, and four pilasters under porch roof, dentilled frieze around porch. Two-panel front door with transom and sidelights. Windows elongated. Rear ell has interior brick chimney.

House possible older than Greek Revival period (no eave overhang on gable ends, small cornice on front, small attic windows). Interior not seen.

Garage modern.

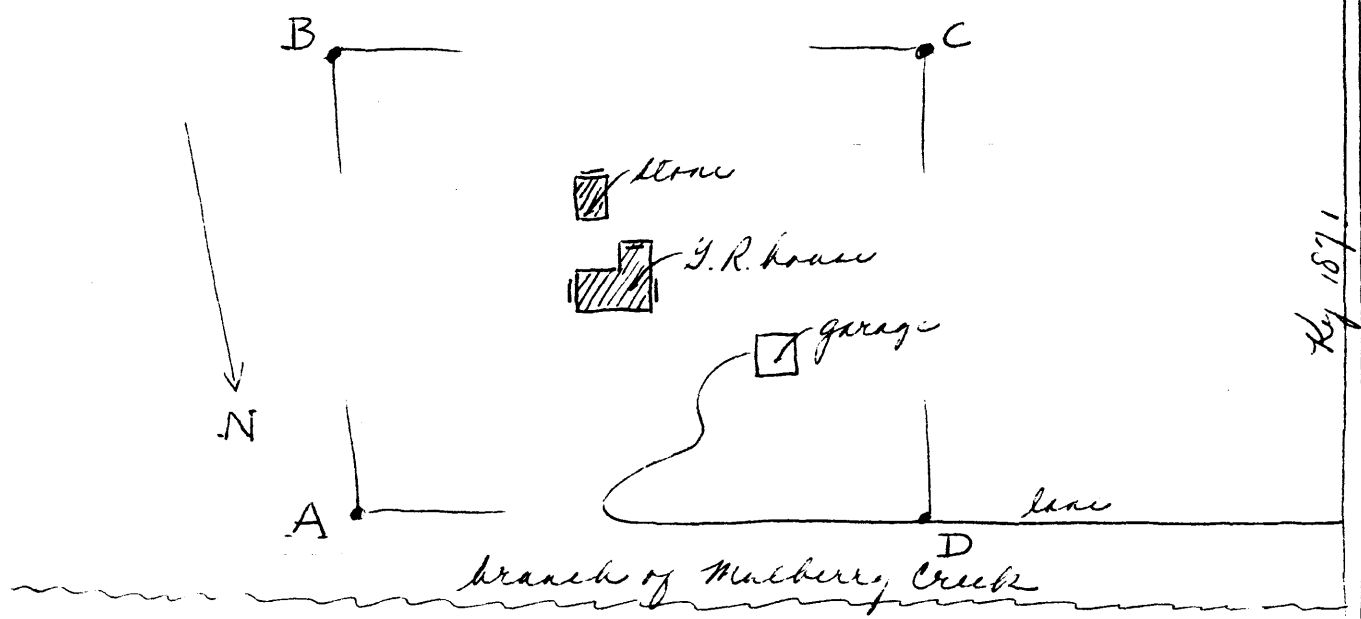

Beginning at A, NE of the house, thence S 460 ft to B, W 525 ft to C, N 525 ft to D at the lane, thence W lane and beyond, E 590 ft to the beginning, containing the frame house and stone dependency.

The barns are outside this boundary, and of a modern period. 2 contrib. bldgs., 1 non contrib bldg.
