

Statement of significance:

This bridge consists of one Pratt half-hip pony truss span, which was a type of truss bridge that was commonly used in Mississippi during the early 20th century. It is significant in that it embodies "the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction." It was preserved in 1983 through an agreement with the Claiborne County Board of Supervisors.
