This tipi is at the Chamberlain SRA. It sits on the south side of Interstate 90. It is located east of the Missouri River on a high bluff. A visitors center/toilet building, refuse cans, interpretive signage, and picnic tables are also located at the SRA. Parking for the SRA is to the east.

The landscape in and around the SRA consists of a variety of grasses. There are also deciduous and coniferous trees. Concrete acceleration and deceleration lanes lead in and out of the SRA.

The tipi retains its historic integrity.

This tipi was built in 1976.

The construction of each tipi was standardized. They are constructed with eight concrete poles. Each pole weighs 6½ tons and is rectilinear in form. The poles are spaced equidistantly and attached at the top with steel plates. The circumference of the tipi's base is 35 feet. There is a three-foot opening where the lodgepoles converge. The tipis are 56 feet tall. Sioux Falls architect Ward Whitwam designed the tipis and the safety rest areas (SRAs).

Statement of Significance Summary Paragraph (Provide a summary paragraph that includes level of significance, applicable criteria, justification for the period of significance, and any applicable criteria considerations.)

The Concrete Interstate Tipis of South Dakota are eligible for the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria A and C. Their level of significance is statewide. However, their significance is better described as regional as the tipis pay tribute not only to South Dakota, but also to indigenous peoples of the northern and southern plains, the American West, and adjoining areas of Canada.

Narrative Statement of Significance (Provide at least one paragraph for each area of significance.)

The tipis are eligible under Criterion A under Entertainment/Recreation for their contribution in promoting tourism. South Dakota's American Indian heritage has drawn visitors since before statehood. The interstate tipis both honor and continue this long-standing tradition.

The tipis are eligible under Criterion A under **Transportation** for their cultural and aesthetic contribution to the interstate highway program. As of 2005, the United States Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration has not determined any similar SRA structures as nationally or exceptionally significant. South Dakota's tipis have been identified as some of the most significant SRA features of the national system.

The Tipis are eligible under Criterion C as works of **Art**. The tipis convey similar aesthetics as sculptures or statues and are recognized for the artistic contribution they add to the SRAs and surrounding landscape.






