Bridge No. 18-100-052 carries a local road over Firesteel Creek approximately 1 mile west and 1.5 miles south of Loomis. This bridge is a single span structure. The 90' span is a riveted and bolted Warren pony truss with a polygonal upper chord, which rests on two massive concrete back walls with concrete wings. The upper chords consist of two steel channel sections riveted with a continuous steel cover plate along their upper flanges and additional batten plates placed at the connections. Along the lower flanges, batten plates are riveted at various intervals. The lower chord consists of two angle sections joined by riveted batten plates while the verticals consist of four angle sections connected with a riveted continuous plate between them. The diagonals are comprised of two angles riveted with batten plates. The bottom laterals are bolted and riveted angle sections forming an 'X' between each floor beam. The railing is comprised of two angle sections with lattice bar. The railings form a very decorative element of this bridge. The south concrete endpost is broken off and exposes square spiral reinforcing bar. This type of truss is an unusual structure in this area of South Dakota. The bridge is set in a very picturesque setting but there is evidence that Firesteel Creek can be ferocious during spring flooding, hence each structure built here is longer in length.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

Bridge no. 18-100-052 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel frame bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C for its association with South Dakota bridge builder, the Pioneer Bridge Company. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

Although out-of-state firms captured the largest share of early 20th century bridge construction projects in South Dakota, there is one notable exception. Fred Bjodstrup of Mitchell maintained a competitive posture relative to out-of-state firms for nearly two decades, eventually being succeeded in 1912 by the Pioneer Bridge Company, managed by his son, Arthur Bjodstrup. Born in Denmark in 1857, Fred Bjodstrup emigrated to the United States in 1876 and moved to South Dakota in 1882. Two years later he moved to Mitchell, where he established a construction business. As early as 1886, he was building bridges in Minnehaha County in partnership with F.P. George, an early Dakota bridge builder based in Parker, South Dakota. Bjodstrup was the principal bridge builder in Davison County from the early 1890s through 1911, and he erected bridges in Miner and Aurora counties in the 1900s while bidding as well in Brown, Hamlin, Sanborn, and other counties. In addition to building bridges, Bjodstrup constructed commercial and other buildings in the Mitchell area. He ceased bidding on projects in 1912 after his son Arthur founded the Pioneer Bridge Company, which continued to receive annual contracts in Davison and Miner counties. Fred Bjodstrup continued working with his son until the early 1920's, when deafness forced him to retire. No bridges built by Bjodstrup prior to the formation of the Pioneer Bridge Company are known to survive.

Bridge No. 18-100-052 is the third bridge built at this crossing. Fred Bjodstrup was commissioned to build at this location a 42 foot bridge in 1892 and a 60 foot steel bridge in 1907. Finally, in May of 1915 the Pioneer Bridge Co. was ordered to build 29 bridges in Davison County, including a 90'x 16'x 20' steel span bridge at this location. Of the eleven Warren truss bridges with a polygonal upper chord found extant in South Dakota, this is the only one that was built by the Pioneer Bridge Company. Because of the small number of in-state bridge builders prior to 1920, bridges such as this one are important representations of attempts by South Dakotan's to compete with established out-of-state companies.
