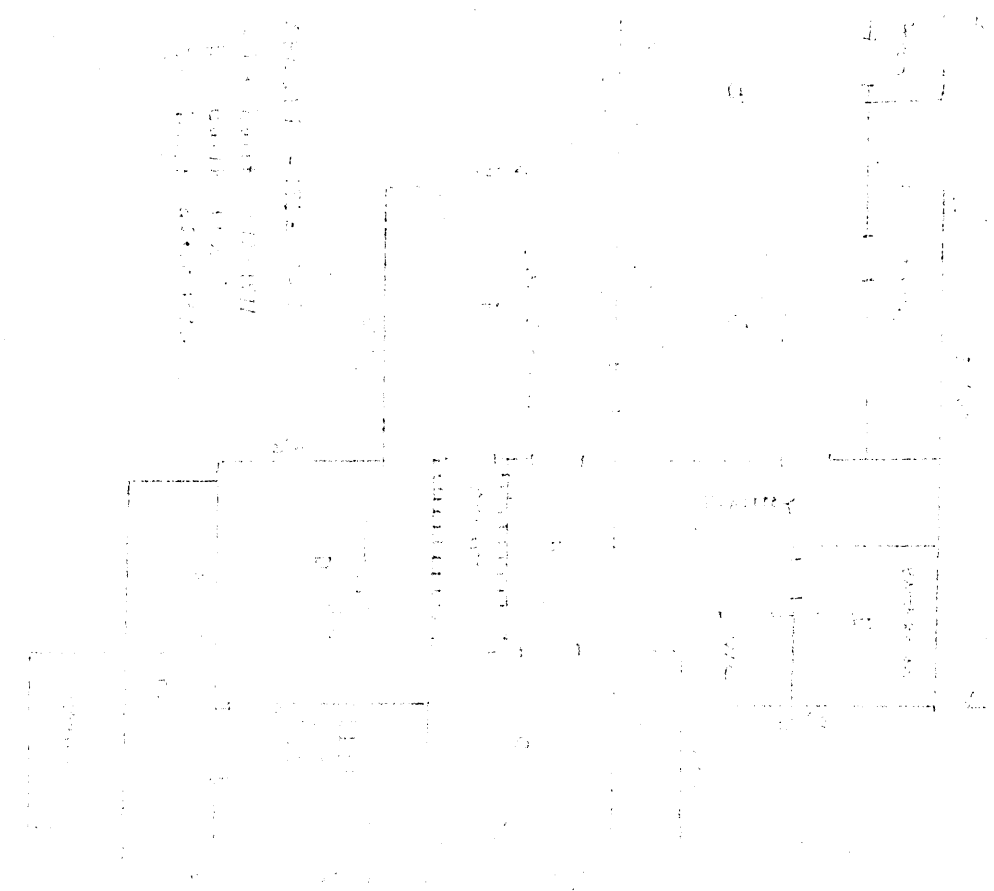

He was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church and a member of the Board of Christian Missions. 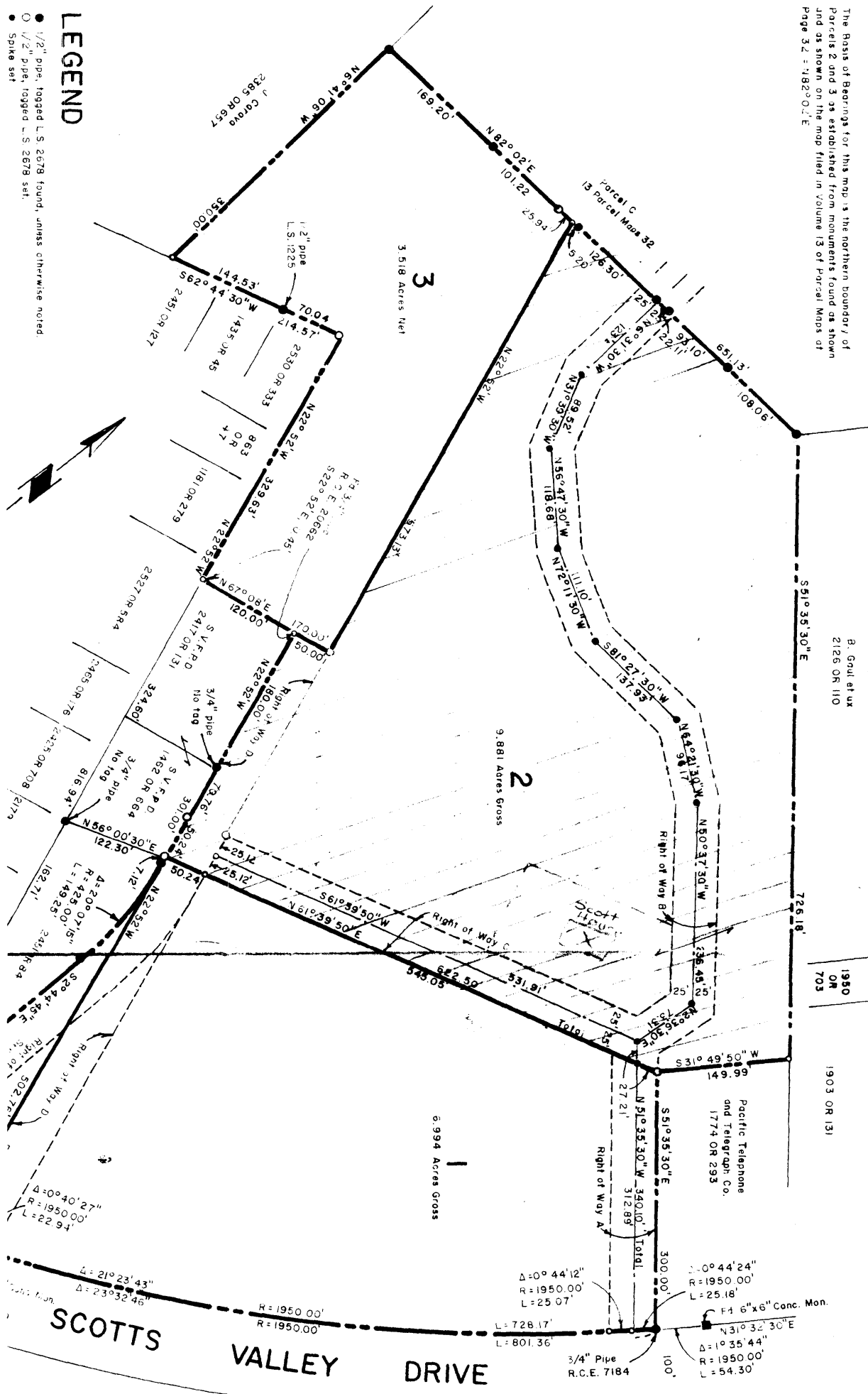
