Narrative Description

"Puente del Treinta", crossing the Prieto River, is located at kilometer 32.7 of PR-128 between Lares and Yauco (Photo 1). The bridge acquired its name "del treinta" (which means "of thirty") because the bridge's location corresponded to kilometer #30 on PR'128 before the road was retraced by the construction of a reservoir in the 1950's. The structure, which displays concrete balustrades and has ornamental parapets on its accesses, has its steel beams encased in concrete. The 18 foot tall piers are adorned with spring courses.

The structure and its setting have suffered no significant alterations since the period of significance. The bridge retains a high degree of integrity of design, workmanship, feeling, association, materials, and setting. A description of the structure follows:

Narrative Statement of Significance

Puente del Treinta, assembled in 1924, due to its excellent condition, beauty and location serves as a representative of longitudinal rolled beam bridges in Puerto Rico. This bridge type was commonly used during the Commonwealth's 1920s highway construction boom. The structure's construction, undertaken by the insular government, was supervised by engineer Enrique Ortega of the Public Works Department and completed at a cost \$13,993.

The erection of this bridge, coupled with an arduous cut through the hard rock formation "La Encantada", helped conclude a 1906 construction project of a difficult 38-kilometer route between Yauco and Lares. This road provided access to Puerto Rico's richest coffee producing region.
