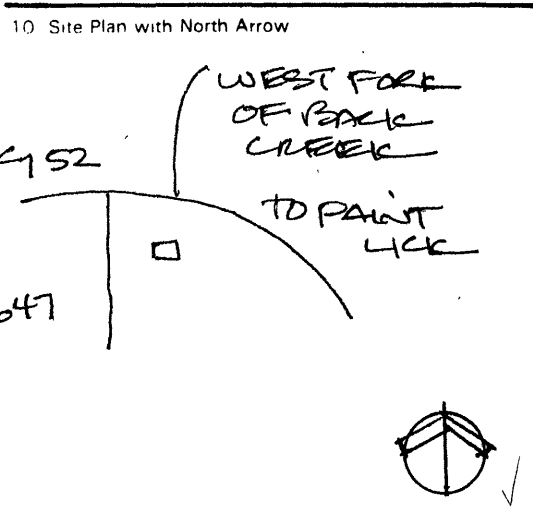

 In 1853 DB S Page 366 - Lewis Y. Leavell owned this property and the community of Point Leavell was named for him.

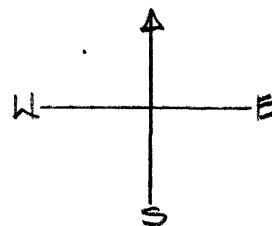
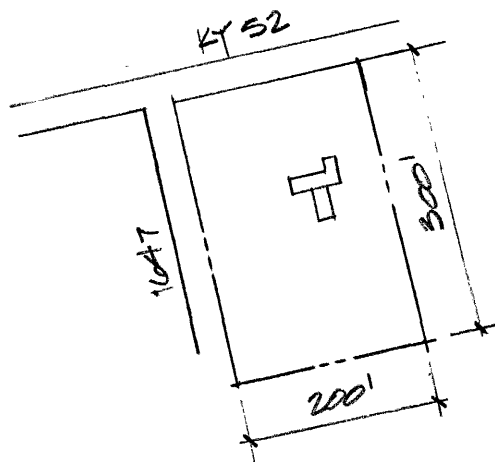

From a point in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Ky. 52 and 1647 then East 200 feet along the South right of way of Ky 52 to a point; then South 300 feet to a point; then West 200 feet to a point; then North along the East right of way of 1647 300 feet to the point of beginning.

The point of beginning is the southeast corner of the intersection of KY 52 and 1647.
