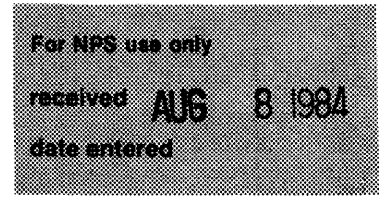

SCOTT AVENUE DISTRICT: DESCRIPTION

The Scott Avenue District is formed by eight residences on the north and south sides of Scott Avenue. Six residences represent variations of the American Four Square style, while the other two are Bungalos. The American Four Square houses are two story, brick and frame, with hip roofs and overhanging eaves. The Bungalos are one and one half stories with gable roofs which overhang the porch and also have wide eaves on the side facades.

SCOTT AVENUE DISTRICT: SIGNIFICANCE

The Scott Avenue District represents Pikeville's best collection of American Four Square residences. These structures demonstrate the most cohesive group of residences in Pikeville from the second decade of the twentieth century in terms of style, materials, scale, and setback. The neighborhood as a whole creates a "sense of time and place."

SCOTT AVENUE DISTRICT: BOUNDARY

Beginning at a point in the southeast corner of the intersection of 6th Street and Scott Avenue proceeding 40 feet northeast to a point of beginning; then 120 feet southeast along the southwest property line of 603 Scott Avenue to a point in the rear property line of 603 Scott Avenue; then 330 feet northeast crossing 7th street to the northeast property line of 703 Scott; then northwest 150 feet crossing Scott to the north side of Scott; then northeast 60 feet to the northeast property line of 704 Scott Avenue; then turning west 180 feet along the north lines of 704, 702, and 700 Scott to the northeast side of 7th Street; then southeast 130 feet to the southeast corner of the intersection of 7th and Scott; then 250 feet southwest to the point of beginning.

SCOTT AVENUE DISTRICT: JUSTIFICATION


