CONSTRUCTION DATE/SOURCE:

Original: mid-18th century, before 1779/
Erskine map; architectural evidence

BUILDER: Garret Garrison

FORM/PLAN TYPE:

Now "H", 3 bay, side hall, 1-1/2 rooms deep with gable end fireplaces (approximately 29' x 29'), with wing type "B" (approximately 14'9" x 22'6").

EXTERIOR WALL FABRIC:

Rubble stone painted white with south front bare and largely unpointed. South front originally stuccoed, but recently removed.

Original 32" x 43"; main 35" x 60" (6/6)
Note: Old photograph shows 3 eyebrow windows in the main section.

ENTRANCE LOCATION/TYPE:

Original: west end bay of south front. 41" x 6'4" M.O. w/ 35" x 6'0" door, possibly indicating a change.

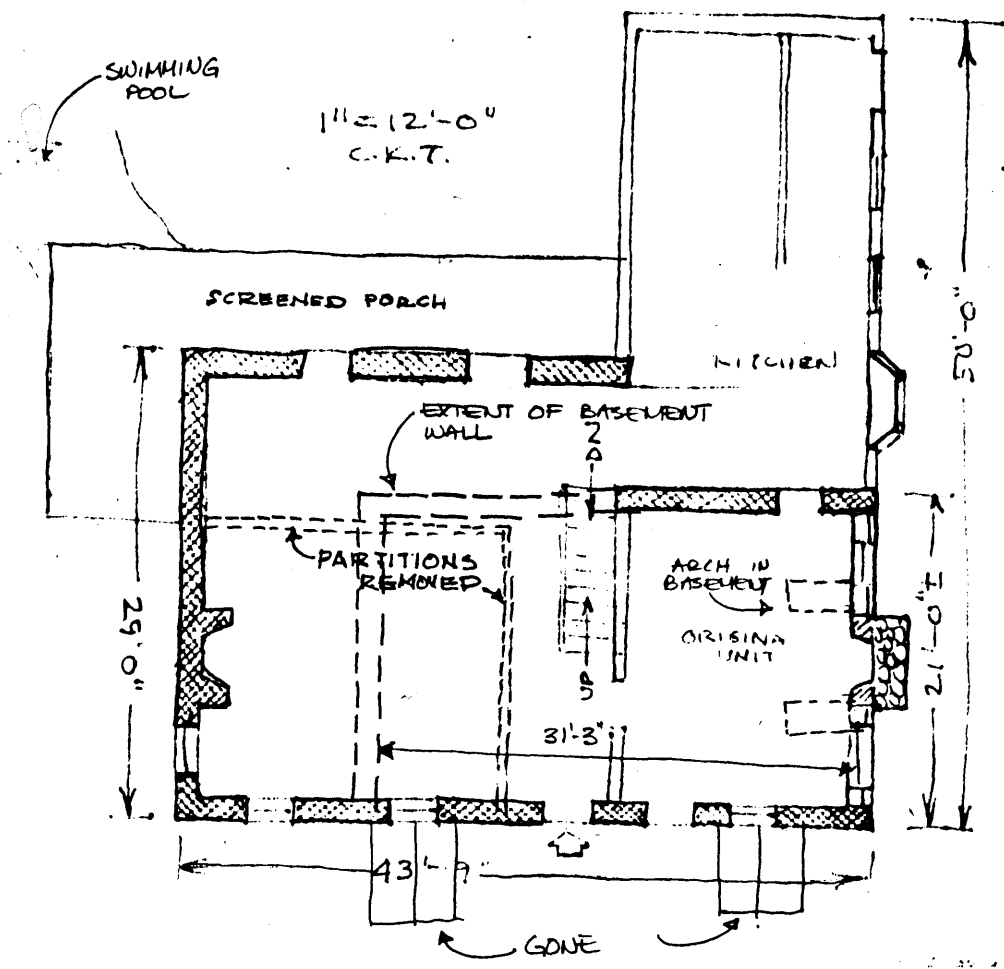
