		STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE	Significant as the buried place of world famous Anderson "Devil Anse" Hatfield-McCoy Feud fame. His life-size statue, an unusual monument for this part of the state, is the only extant site associated with his life. His wife and most of their 13 children, many of whom were principal characters in the feud, are buried here as well. See Item 8 of National Register Form for more thorough statement.
