Verbal Boundary Description

Acreage @ .25 ACRES

There are no distinguishing features defining the property boundaries. Therefore, the site is bounded by a domestic living space of 30' on all sides. Beginning at point A approximately 40' from the NW corner of the house; thence is a straight line parallel to and 30' distant from the W wall approximately 100' to point B; thence in a straight line parallel to and 30' distant from the S wall approximately 120' to point C; then in a straight line parallel to and 30' distant from the E wall approximately 100' to point C; thence is a straight line parallel to and 30' distant from the N wall to the beginning.
