This building was erected in 1900.) It was the first important building for Madera after it became a county. The citizens of Madera County have always been very proud of their Courthouse and were sorry when it was decided the building was not adequate for county government unless a large sum be spent to bring up to present day requirements.

It will make a fine museum. No changes will be made other than to make it safe. In its day it was considered a very fine building. Madera County started its first library in the Courthouse also.

It is located near the highway, easily accessible to tourists, has a lovely park adjoining it.

The people of Madera County hope the building will be used as a museum and its historic value will add to its attraction as a museum.

Madera County came into existence in 1893, created from a part of Fresno, some 40 years after the organization of that county. Madera has been the county seat from the beginning; thus, the Madera County Courthouse. For sixty years the Courthouse served as the administrative and political center for a largely agricultural oriented population.
