DESCRIPTION:

The elevated water tank at Deerwood is a 50,000 gallon cylindrical metal tank with hemispherical bottom, balcony, and simple red painted conical roof with finial. It is connected by circular girder with a 100 foot, three panel, four post, lattice girder trestle tower with diagonal tie rods, ladder, riser pipe, and manufacturer's plate. The community's name is lettered on the tank.
