Dear Sir

Obedient to your Request I purchased

A 4 year old Horse for you which I send
to the care of John Chamberlain who will
probably deliver the same to you the horse
has not been fairly broke but has worked
with another horse & is said to good so far as
has been worked I wish you to take him
and allow what you can I paid seven
seventy Dollars for him & a part in cash
He will cost me eighty Dollars when
I get him to Waterloo you may think
him high at that price but he will
make a first rate horse likely but it
will be best for us both for you to
give on the price if you can as I write
to Mr Chamberlain to ~~for~~ transact the
Business for me
