ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

One-story hip-roof frame residence with cross-gable additions. Entrance frontispiece has etched side lights, pilasters, and slightly pedimented architrave trim. Center-hall plan. Interior details include a ceiling medallion and paneled wainscoting in three rooms.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

This is one of Shubuta's only antebellum homes and at one time was the home of Jenny McPhail Price and her sister, who came from South Carolina on a wagon train. Before the turn of the century this was the home of W. H. Patton, a prominent citizen and businessman of Shubuta. He was an alderman and major of the town, a deacon of the Baptist church, and a member of the state executive committee of the Prohibition Party.
