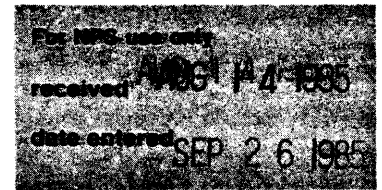

4. Owner: Frank Carrillo, 16 Grand, Las Vegas, N.M.
7. Description: Rectangular shape, long side to street, front and rear shed-roofed porches; sandstone foundation; light brown ashlar sandstone walls (front) random ashlar (sides), dark brown quoins; asphalt shingle roof, one shed dormer with wood shingle sides; 1/1, 2/2 double-hung windows with dark brown sills and lintels; single door with transom; brick porch wall, tapered wooden piers with molding "bases" and "capitals," exposed rafters. Located next to #1194; see discussion there for more on location.
8. Significance: Built before 1902, this is basically the same house as its neighbor to the south, Building #1194, and the things written about that structure on the previous page apply here. This house was remodeled in the 1920's, however, by the addition of porches and consolidation of dormers. The shed dormer complements the new Bungalow style porch. The engaged porch piers obscure the original dark quoin accent. The two houses standing side-by-side, the original and a good later remodeling, form an interesting pair.
