drooping to Licking R. on north.

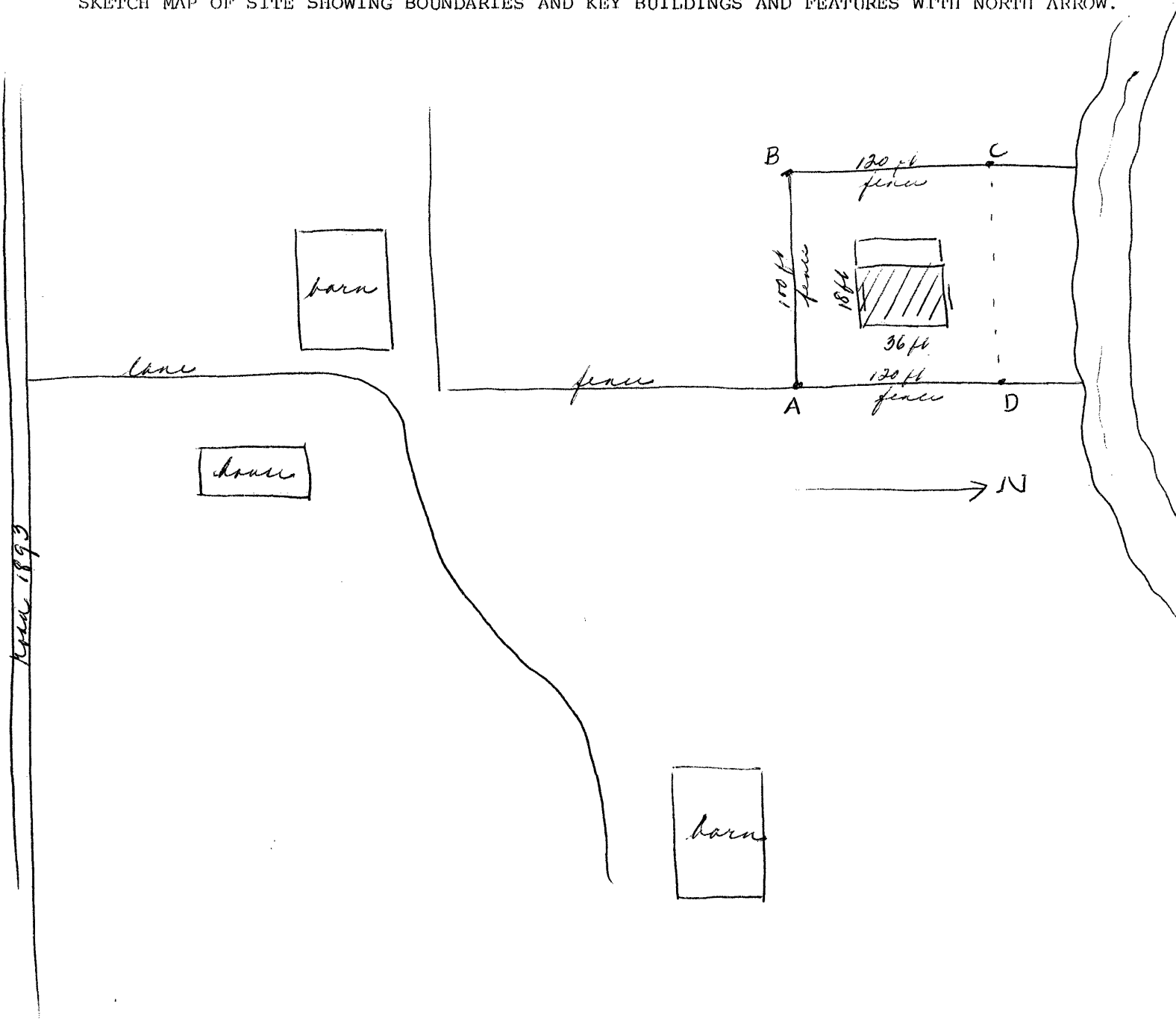

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at a fence corner SE of the stone house, thence with fence 100 W to B and 120 ft N to C, thence a right angle to fence 100 E to D, thence W fence 120 ft S to the beginning enclosing the stone house - about 1/4 acre. No other buildings at site.
