#### Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

The Belmont-Hillsboro neighborhood is a twenty-block area located approximately two miles south-southeast of the central business district of Nashville, between Twenty-first Avenue, S. (Hillsboro Road) on the west and Belmont Boulevard on the east. Its northern boundary is Magnolia Boulevard, and its southern boundary is a cleared right-of-way for the as yet unbuilt interstate 440.

The nominated district is within these general boundaries. The northern boundary is Magnolia Boulevard. Because of the consistency of architectural merit along Belmong Boulevard, the district includes both sides of this street with the boundary line following the alley right-of-way immediately to the east of Belmont. The southern boundary is an irregular line, north of the interstate right-of-way, dividing blocks developed in the teens and 1920s from others developed in the late 1930s and late 1940s. The western boundary at no point extends all the way to Twenty-first Avenue because of commercial development on that street which has destricted the residential character it once had. Generally the western boundary follows the alley right-of-way immediately east of Twenty-first.

The neighborhood is laid out in a regular grid which belies the visual variety the area enjoyabecause of its topography. A series of sharp hills and ridges in the area results in both steeply and gently sloping streets with no two blocks looking quite the same. The area is heavily wooded with mature trees. Two blocks of Cedar Lane and two of Brightwood Avenue contain twenty-feet-wide medians which are shaded with large maple trees.

There are 603 buildings within the nominated area, the overwhelming majority of which are middle-class, single-family dwellings of relatively modest scale. Among the contributing building there are also several originally constructed as duplexes and two-or-three-story multifamily apartment buildings. There are 69 non-contributing buildings in the district.

Discounting the expected pauses for the Depression and World War II, construction in Belmont-Hillsboro has gone on more or less continuously since the turn of the century when the area was first subdivided. The most concentrated construction activity took place between 1905 and 1920 but continued through the 1920s, by which time most of the nominated area was built up. Construction has continued on the few vacant lots in the area to the present and is currently underway on a previously vacant lot on Linden Avenue. With only two exceptions, every post-1930 building in the district is residential in character, and most are unobtrusive in scale and design. The small number and low visual profile of the non-contributing buildings do little to interfere with the solid architectural consistency found in Belmont-Hillsboro.

The oldest building within the district is the Montgomery plantation outbuilding located at 1806 Cedar Lane (photo #1). The main plantation house, which was burned during the Civil War, was located nearby to the east at the crest of the hill where Cedar Lane and Brightwood intersect. The outbuilding's original use is not known, but it is thought to have been a smokehouse Its configuration and proximity to the big house could bear this out. The building, for many years a private residence, is a four-room, two-story structure of handmade brick, one room deep and two rooms across. A single, centrally located chimney rises above the gable roof. Twentieth century frame one-story additions on the east and north sides and a canopy over the street facade door little alter the building's original simple dignity.

Twentieth century buildings in Belmont-Hillsboro fall neatly into seven distinct categories, reflecting diversity of taste at any given time and changing fashion over the passing years. Fifteen one- or one and one-half-story houses with neoclassic decorative treatment form the smallest and earliest of these categories. This type of house, constructed mainly between 1900 and 1915 and much more common in other, somewhat older Nashville neighborhoods, is found in two distinct configurations, corner porch houses and front porch houses. The corner porch house (photo #2) is usually older than the front porch type and is quite close in plan to Victorian Queen Anne cottages of a decade or two earlier. This similarity often carries over to interior detailing as well. The front porch variety (photos  $4 \ \epsilon \ 5$ ) has a porch running across the front and generally features a symmetrical facade and has a more formal interior plan and more consistent neoclassic decorative treatment throughout than the corner porch type. Thes houses are about evenly divided between brick and frame construction with a few Belmont Hillsboro examples, such as the unusual gambrel-roofed house at 1914 Eighteenth Avenue (photo #3), built of concrete block imitating rockfaced stone.

Coming into popularity in the first decade of this century is another type of house locally referred to as the four-square (Photos 6-11). The four-square is a square box of a house, as the name implies, with a hipped roof rising to a single point at the center and pierced by a gable at the center on the street side. The street facade generally has four large windows arranged symmetrically and a door at the center on the ground floor (photo #6). Smaller examples of this type have the door at one side of the street facade balanced on the other side by a large window (photo #7). squares are generally built of brick, with some stone examples, and some combining ston with shingles or clapboard. Very few are of all wooden construction. Occasionally four-squares designed for specific clients became a bit eccentric. The house at 1800 Cedar (photo #9), for example, is slightly off-center and has a flat-topped roof. four-square's popularity continued from the first decade of this century well into the 1920s. Earlier examples almost universally employed neoclassic motifs on entrance porches and on interior woodwork as well in some examples. The similarity between early four-squares and contemporary neoclassic cottages can readily be seen (compare photos 5 & 6). Later examples are found with both neoclassic (photo #10) and bungaloid (photo #11) exterior treatment. Four-square interiors, including those of many early examples with neoclassic exterior trim, were most often done in the simple, angular bungaloid/craftsman style. There are 96 four-square houses in Belmont-Hillsboro, second in number to bungalows.

With well over 300 examples, the bungalow (photos 12-23) is the most common building type found in Belmont-Hillsboro, helping to impart the middle-middle class ambiance the district has. Belmont-Hillsboro bungalows come in an astounding variety of designs no two look exactly alike, and yet they provide a consistency of scale and design concept that ties the entire area together visually. Aside from the ever present and ever varied front porch, building materials provide visual variety. Frame (photos 12, 13,

14), brick (photos 17, 21), stone (photo 22) and brick combined with stone (photo 15), stucco (photo 16), shingles (photo 18), or half-timber (photo 23) bungalows can all be found in Belmont-Hillsboro. Size varies from small, single-story houses (photos 13, 14) to rather large ones with a good bit of usable space above the main floor (photo 23 Generally size falls between these two extremes. The typical Belmont-Hillsboro bungalo is a modest one and one-half-story house with one or perhaps two usable rooms under the roof (photos 12, 19, 20, 21).

A number of two-story houses in Belmont-Hillsboro share with the bungalows their distinctive architectural style but, because of their full two and, in some cases, two and one-half stories, they cannot be called bungalows. Many of these houses look as if they had been taken directly from the pages of Gustav Stickney's The Craftsman magazine and in the nomination are referred to as craftsman-style houses (photos 24-26). These houses vary in plan. Some are not unlike four-squares but invariably have gabled roofs rather than hipped, and their windows are grouped in two's and three's rather than being placed singly as with most four-squares. Of course, neoclassic detail is not to be found. Other craftsman houses differ considerably from four-square in plan, such as the L-shaped clapboard house at 1713 Blair (photo 24). The Belmont-Hillsboro craftsman-style exterior finish is frequently brick, but often stone, stucco, shingle, and clapboard are also seen, all of which are more typical than brick of The Craftsman magazine designs.

Many Belmont-Hillsboro houses of the 1920s reflect a shift in fashion away from the distinctive bungalow style. A modestly scaled English Tudor revival house (photos 27, 28, 29) was quite popular in the neighborhood. More often than not, these were one and one-half-story houses not unlike larger bungalows in plan. There were also built several gambrel-roofed Dutch Colonial style houses (photo 30), some of stone, some of clapboard, which vary widely in their adherence to historic architectural precedents. Similarly varied in their respect for authentic forms are several more or less Colonial Georgian style houses (photo 31). Some of these appear to be nothing other than a four-square with a Georgian doorway, while others, as the house in photo 31, boast more carefully authentic detailing and appear to have a more authentic, central hall plan. Other 1920s houses do not reflect any specific revival style but seem to be not unlike bungalows in size and planning. These houses (photos 32 and 33) are generally of brick and are one- or one and one-half-story. The ever present bungalow front porch has been moved to the side, the wide overhangs have been cut back almost flush with the walls, and entrances and porch openings often are arched. The overall effect is rather like an English Tudor revival without the half-timbering. In the following list these are referred to simply as post-bungalow style houses.

Apartments are yet another category of buildings in Belmont-Hillsboro (photos 34-36). These buildings, not to be confused with duplexes designed to look as much as possible like single-family houses or single-family houses subsequently divided, contain four or

more apartments and are two or three stories high. While two of these buildings, Ivy Lodge, 1920 Portland Avenue (photo 36) and The Clair, 2804-06 Belmont Blvd., are recognizably English Tudor in style, the others display no particular style other than that typical of early twentieth century suburban apartment buildings. The Sterling Court buildings, 2101-2109 Belmont Blvd., while rather nondescript themselves, have a charming bungalow-style bus shelter, a graceful gesture to neighboring houses (photo 56). There are twelve apartment buildings in the district, and, despite their size, they fit nicely into the residential scale of the neighborhood.

Nonconforming buildings (photos 37-40) are the seventh and final group of buildings. Dates of construction range from the late 1930s to the late 1970s. Most of these are single-story duplexes while there are also several single-family houses as well. Brick is the predominant exterior material. These buildings are for the most part compatible in scale with their older neighbors and are not blatantly obtrusive. The two non-residential buildings in this group are single-story, flat-roofed commercial structures. Currently under construction in the 1700 block of Linden Avenue is a pair of semi-detached single-family houses in a poorly handled imitation of American Colonial architecture which will possibly prove more intrusive than the less pretentious duplexes of the 1950s and 160s. As a group, the non-compatible buildings do very little damage to the architectural consistency of this early twentieth century neighborhood.

#### Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

Belmont-Hillsboro was developed in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries as Nashville, a formerly compact town, began, with the advent of street cars and later the automobile to spread outward and engulf surrounding farm lands. Parts of two significant estates, those of Colonel and Mrs. Joseph Acklen and of Colonel A.B. Montgomery, were subdivided into what is Belmont-Hillsboro. No buildings of the Acklen estate are left standing within the district boundary, but immediately adjacent to the northwest is the campus of Belmont College which centers on the Acklens' justly famous Greek Revival house, Belmont, a National Register proper ty. The Montgomery plantation house stood on the hill where Cedar Lane and Brightwood Avenue intersect but was burned by Col. Montgomery during the Civil War Battle of Nashville to keep it from falling into the hands of the advancing Union Army. Two plantation outbuildings still stand, one of which is within the district boundary at 1806 Cedar Lane.

More significant than the history of the land is the neighborhood's architectural character. From the first area subdivision in the 1890s to the last in the early 1920s, the building in Belmont-Hillsboro goes through recognizable changes in architectural style. What does not change is the scale of the buildings. While tastes changed, the wealth and social pretensions of the builders did not. The houses and apartment buildings of Belmont-Hillsboro, with a few exceptions on both ends of the scale, are the middle-sized, comfortable homes of the middle-middle class. No famous names were early twentieth-century residents of Belmont-Hillsboro. It was, and is today, the home of the largely nameless middle class and is a vivid and nearly intact reflection of average American lifestyle from 1890 to 1930.

Additionally, Belmont Boulevard is the last of Nashville's radiating main traffic arteries to retain its residential character. While not lined with the imposing houses some other Nashville avenues were, its width and essentially intact character serve as Nashville's last example of the grand residential avenue, now rapidly vanishing from the American scene.

In the years following the Second World War, Belmont-Hillsboro suffered decline common to many older neighborhoods as suburban development continued to spread outward. Declining property values, slumlords, and lack of building maintenance began to be serious problems. While these problems are not yet completely eliminated, the trend has been reversed largely due to the efforts of the Belmont-Hillsboro Neighbors, Inc. The group, organized ten years ago, is the oldest neighborhood association in Nashville and has been a strong force in developing a stable atmosphere in the neighborhood and insuring a good future for the neighborhood's buildings.
