**STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

John B. Allen constructed his residence and store in 1873. A wall of adobe surrounded the complex that also consisted of storage buildings, stables and sleeping quarters. An arched entryway separated the living spaces from the Officer's Bar and store. Extensive renovation has been undertaken by the present owners.
