ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: structure; however, the structural supports are of later addition, the rear porch also was under the original roof system and has been closed in to form two additional rooms; interior floor plan--central hall plan with two rooms on either side with later addition to rear; grounds are sparse grass with several small shrubs and two shade trees on city right of way in front of house.

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE: during hot and humid long summers experienced in region.
