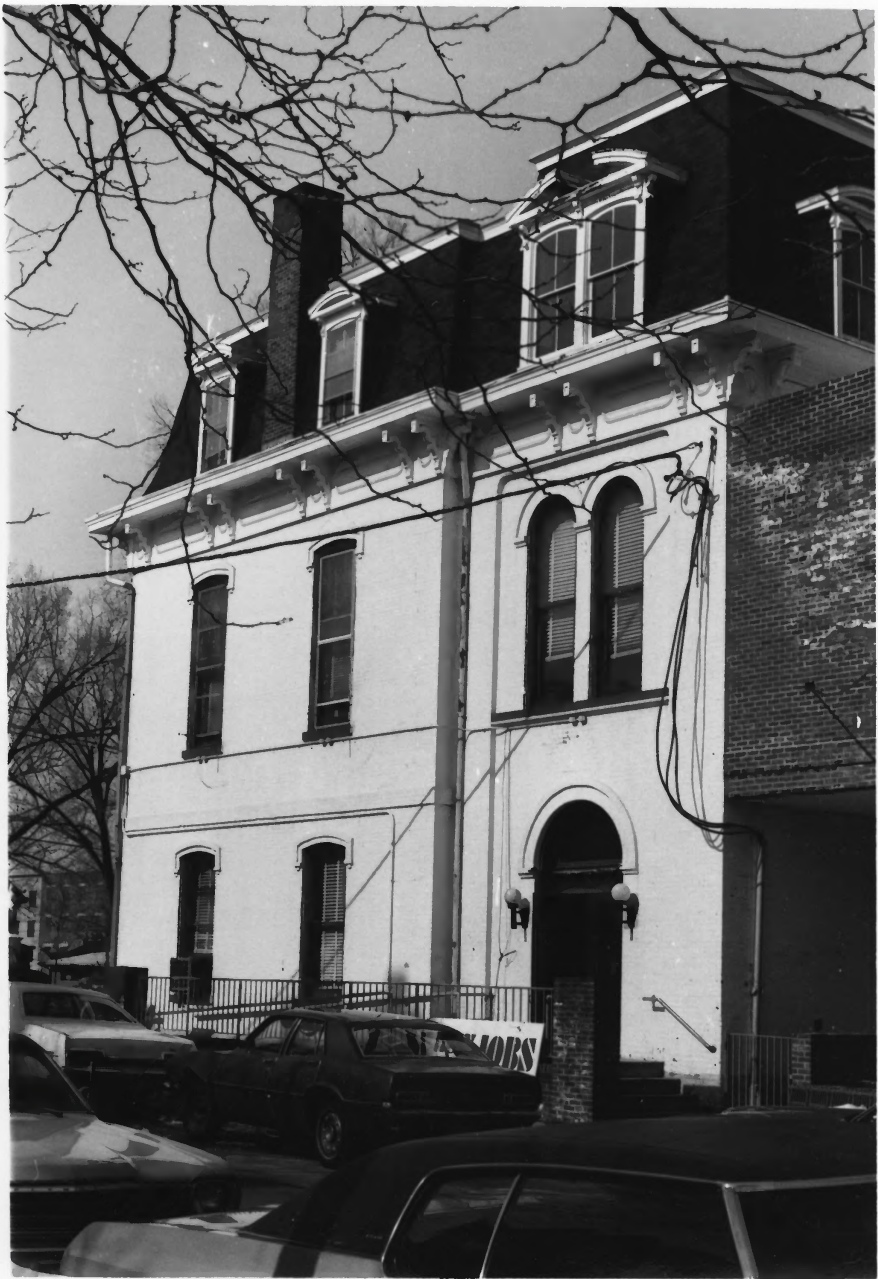

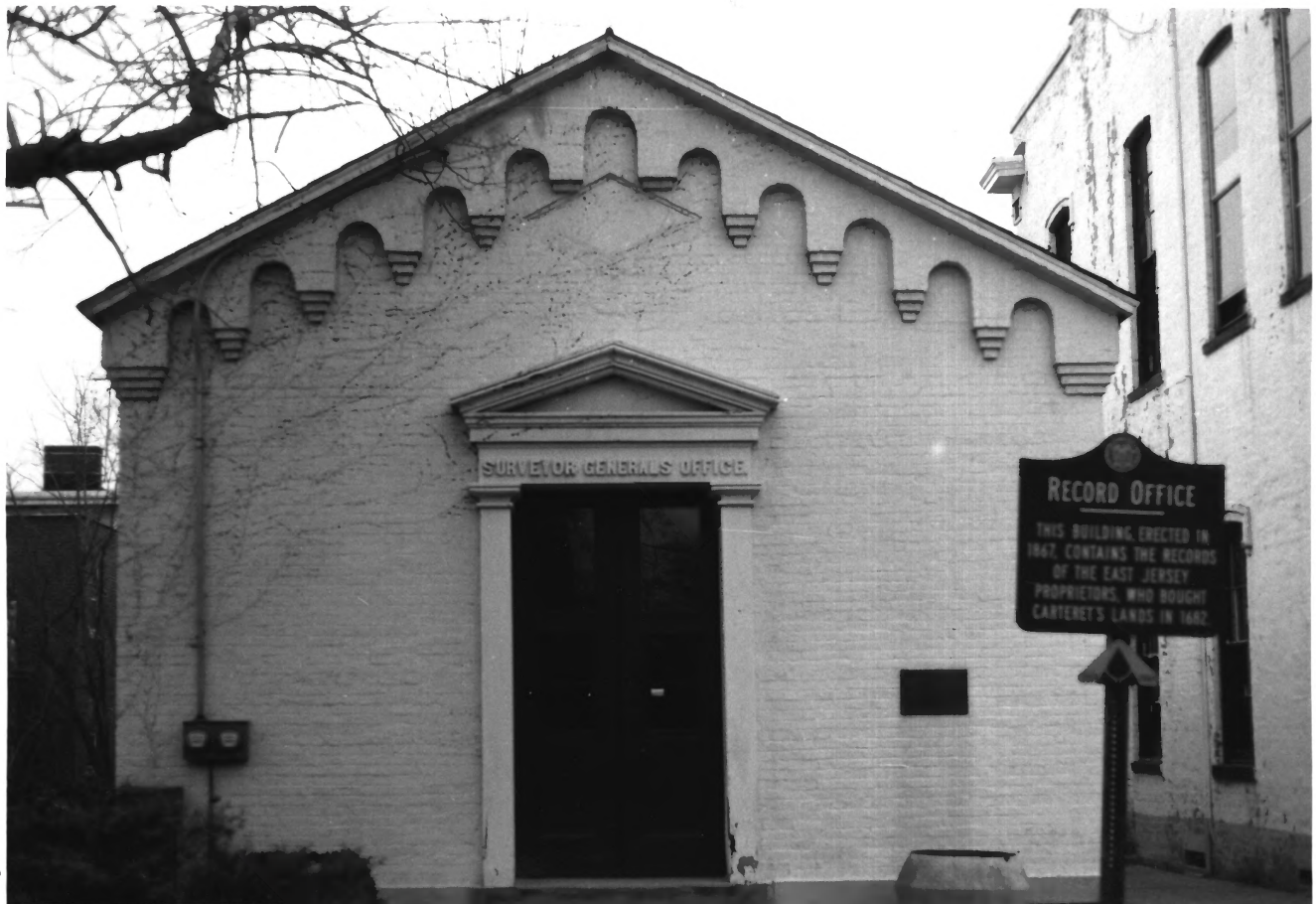

Perth Amboy City Hall as it looked before 1909, when the north wing was added. Built in 1766, it remained as originally constructed until 1872 when the mansard roof was added. The building has been used for town house, courts, a school; housed the police station from 1909 to 1935; was sold to private ownership and repurchased by the city in the 1800's. An earlier building on the site, existing in 1713, was destroyed by fire in 1765.
