## 45. Description and House Plan:

Two-story, three-bay, dry-stone building—combination jailer's quarters and jail cells. Interior gable end chimney east end, interior chimney between two southwest rooms. Voussoirs above windows, square stone sills. Masonry in regular courses of unequal height, squared edges, tooled face, Flemish bond, steeple pointing; stone is Laurel Dolomite; building size ca.  $36 \times 56$ . Plan has transverse hall across front of building, three rooms across rear. U-stair at west end of hall, original windows first floor east gable end, three bays first floor, door in left bay, two bays second floor not aligned. Residential rooms have Federal woodwork, one shelf mantel, one breakfront with reeded corner blocks. Second floor plan the same, without fireplaces; rooms lined with  $6 \times 12$  feet hewn planks.


To the rear of the first building is a five-bay, two-story, dry-stone jail building, built perpendicular to the first, 42 feet long, connected by a one story hyphen, and surrounded by a stone wall, providing exercise space for the prisoners. In this building, the stones are rough-faced (spalled) with square cut edges. Building has hipped roof, dentilled cornice of stone, and stone sills, headers, and jambs. Stones have holes as at MU-1, probably to accommodate a tool for lifting into place.

Small, two-story, shed roofed brick addition west of hyphen.

Buildings still in use as county jail and residence and office of jailer.
