


PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION:  <i>This house, known for half a century as the Knights-Morey house is of the cape style common to most of Goshen's three-inch plank structures, but has a high gable roof allowing a small room above the second level. The main block is roughly 32' x 26', three bays across and two deep. It is sheathed with clapboards, has a brick chimney centered on the ridge, and a larger exposed chimney on the west end. There is a skylight on both front and rear slopes of the roof. The 2/2 sash windows and central door have plain surrounds and the windows are flanked by shutters. A hip roofed porch supported by turned posts and embellished by a turned valence runs the length of the front and has uncut fieldstone steps. The ell is flush with the main block's facade and is roughly 23' x 23'. The door and windows have plain surrounds. An attached post and beam barn/shed extends to the east; its sides are mostly open and it is roofed with wooden shakes. The balance of the property is wooded.</i>			
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:  <i>This structure includes an unusual feature in the room found above the second level, approximately 16 feet wide. Round hardwood poles serving as joists made the supports for this level running lengthwise of the house between cross timbers into which they were gained, noted Walter R. Nelson in recording this construction. The house, constructed c. 1830, is also interesting for its use of turned wooden detailing on the porch. It is the only plank house which conveys these Italianate or perhaps Stick Style characteristics.</i>

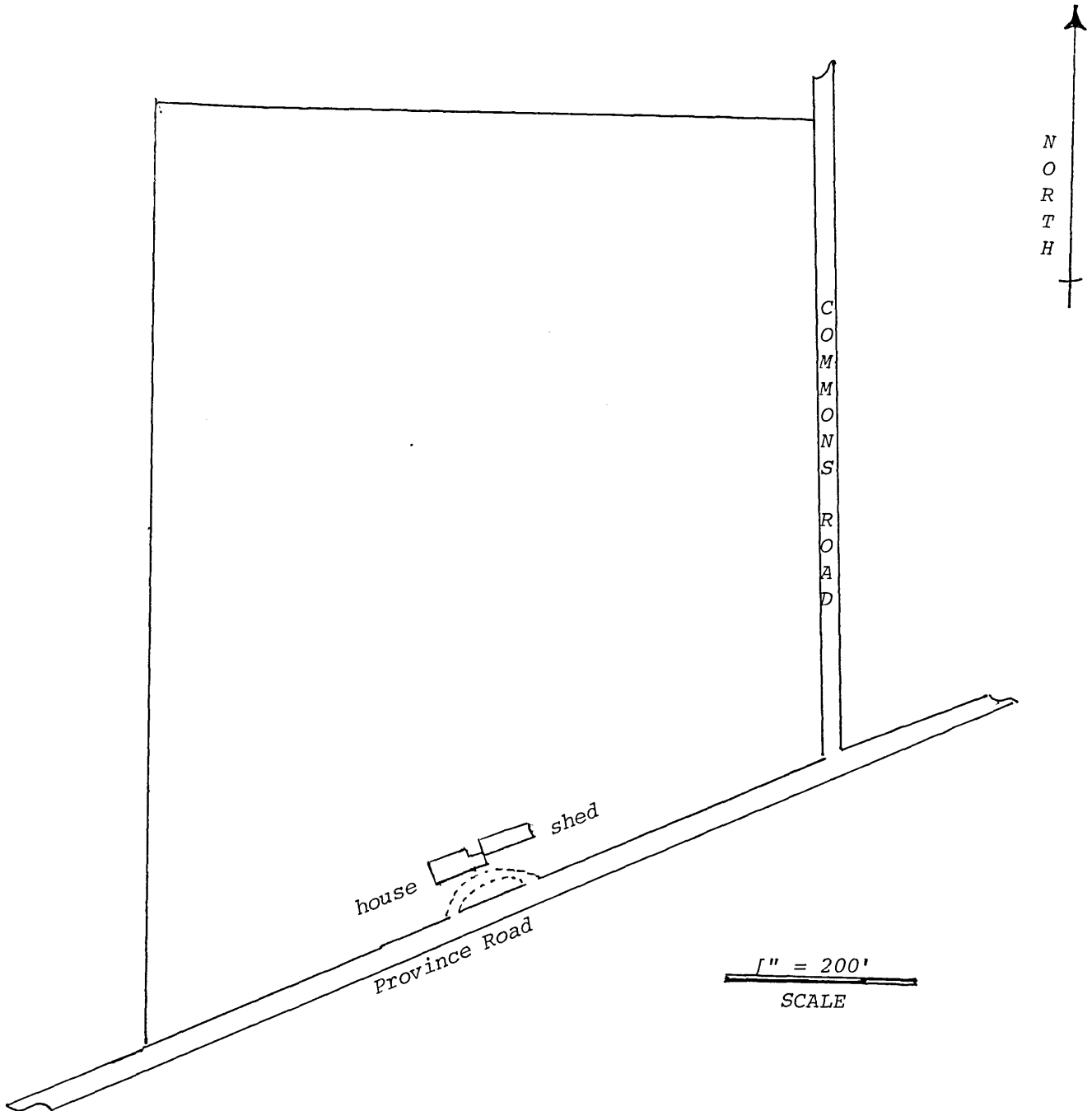
