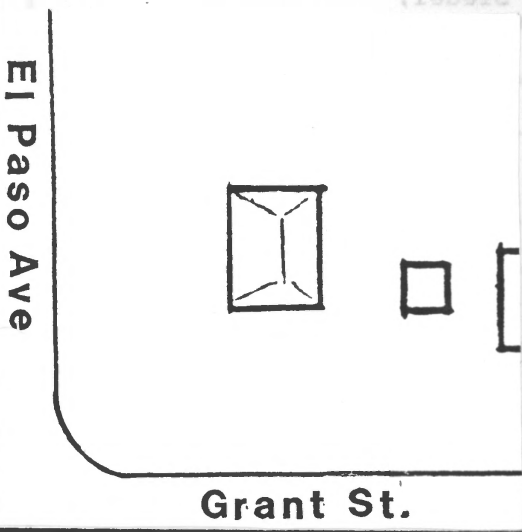

DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED: Best intact example of brick Craftsman Bungalow in Willcox. Associated with prominent 1920's lawyer and later City Attorney, J.C. Gung'l, who also owned the water company for many years. Gung'l went to El Paso to obtain the design for his home and later imported the bricks from El Paso.
