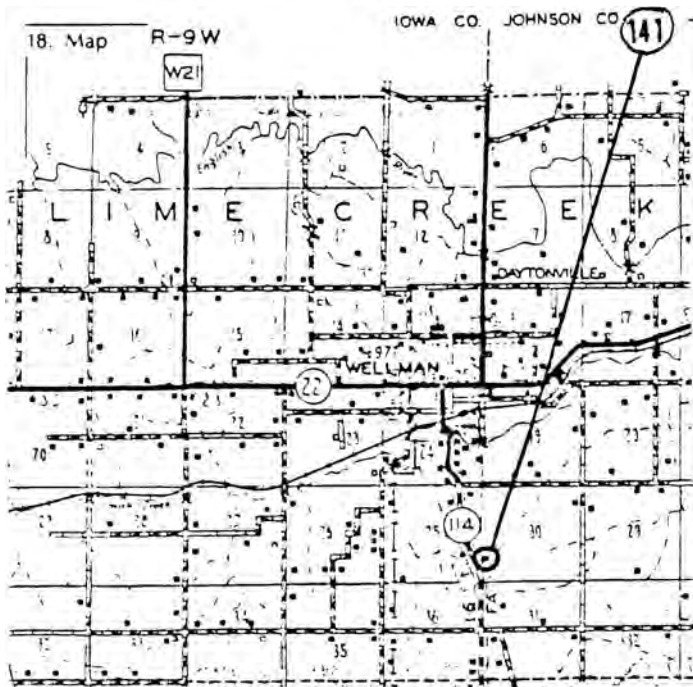

Characterized as a hog barn by the fifteen pens built around the perimeter, and by the many windows in both the roof and in the exterior wall. Light and ventilation in hog barns were a concern of this time. The construction, in the early 20th century, of special function barns represented as important experimental shift in the traditional use of the barn.
