Additional Architectural Description:

This handsome Georgian Revival church contains many of the features associated w/ this particular style.

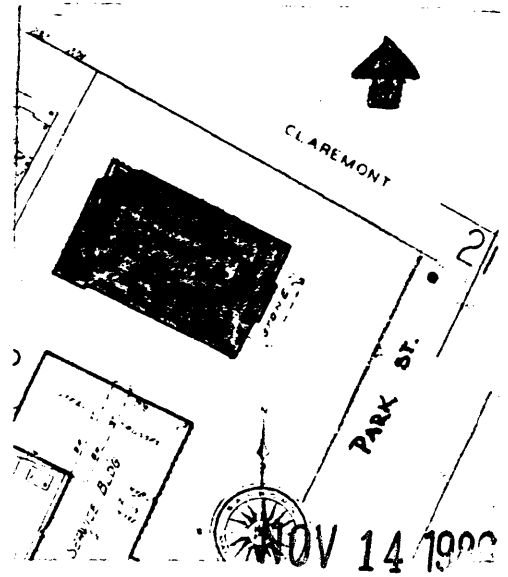
Significant are the main portico w/ Doric columns, simple frieze & denticulated cornice, the main & side entrances adorned w/ broken pediments, & the round arched windows which dominate the side elevations.

A delicate, octagonal spire adorns the gabled roof, & a stepped, parapet wall w/ decorative urns joins into the base of the tower.
