Dear Ms. Shull:

On 7 June 1982 St. Mary's Convent, a part of the Colony of St. Gregory of Nazianzen Thematic Resources (St. Nazianz, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin), was Determined Eligible by the National Park Service due to owner objection. We have received a notarized letter (attached) from the sole owners of the property requesting that the property be listed on the National Register. A staff review indicates that the documentation submitted in 1982 continues to reflect the current condition of the property. Furthermore, the convent continues to meet the criteria for registration in the areas of Community Planning and Exploration/Settlement for which it was first nominated. Because of the change in sentiment by the property owner, we request that the Owner Objection be removed and that St. Mary's Convent in St. Nazianz be officially listed in the National Register.
