#### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Constructed in 1851 for Troy Gordon, the house is a lovely example of Greek Revival architecture, and a charming reminder of Fayetteville's past. One outstanding feature of the structure is its symmetrical dig-A small central portico, covered with a high gabled roof and braced by round Doric columns and two Doric pilasters, are the originals. The round pillars, supporting the portico, are actually massive for this size house. The exterior paint, similar to a Williamsburg Blue, was hand mixed to get the exact shade desired and is accented with a stark white trim. The restoration has replaced the exterior cement flooring under the portico with old bricks which have also been used to form a curbed walkway to the street. Four 4/4 6' sash windows, most of which still retain their original hand blown glass, are positioned symmetrically across the front of the house. Any new glass that has to be added is being replaced by hand blown glass panes found in old homes that are being demolished.

The floor plan is the symmetrical four-room, central-hall. The dimensions of the hall are 8'x14'x14', and two original front rooms (double parlors flanking the central hall) are a uniform 16'3"x15'2"x14'. Each room contains its original woodburning fireplace, still in excellent operating condition, and classically-designed mantel, highlighting the 12' ceilings. The interior of the main section of the house remains undisturbed except for the two original rear rooms which were burned during the Civil War and shortly afterwards rebuilt. A second addition and two porches were added later. A small bathroom is wainscotted with beaded ceiling boards. The pine floors have been refinished, and include wooden base moldings, which are classically simple yet elegant. The original plaster remains on the walls and ceilings.

The house sits on a stone foundation and 2x12 oak floor joists. outbuildings, one a native stone barn which has served as a smokehouse and fruit cellar, the other an oak shed, also occupy the grounds. Both are now used as storage. A deep brick and stone walled well is located a few feet northwest of the house and is also preserved.

The house is located on one acre of the original 80, framed by two giant maple trees, and shaded by other maples and oaks, which give the setting an atmosphere of quiet serenity heightened by the very pleasing symmetrical architectural lines. The grounds are landscaped by flower gardens and shrub beds, planted with typical plantings of the Southern Colonial Period, to screen a parking area.

Many arduous hours have been spent supervising painstaking detail and precision reconstruction, in the attempt to restore this old house to its previous dignity and stature.

SPECIFIC DATES

The Troy Gordon House in Fayetteville is an architecturally significant structure. Constructed c. 1851, the weatherboard Greek Revival House is marked by symmetrical features typical of that style. As one of the few surviving ante-bellum structures in the state, the Gordon House is a significant example of its period.

The land upon which the Gordon House is located was patented by William Skelton and Thomas Banks. Historical records indicate that William Skelton with his brother-in-law Troy Gordon, Alexander Standfield and Hosea Cardwell moved to Fayetteville in 1827. Troy Gordon remained in Fayetteville while the other men returned to Tennessee to bring back their families.

Skelton and Banks sold the property to Troy Grodon and his mother in 1836. The deed transfer at this date indicates that the property "included lot and stables". Troy Gordon sold the property back to Skelton in 1852 and by then the deed included a house, lot and stables. William Skelton's daughter married Robert S. Anderson in 1865 and the property was known for many years as the Anderson Farm.

This clapboard Greek Revival house is one of the oldest still standing in Washington County, and has a past that reflects the development of the city of Fayetteville. In addition, it is being actively used for office space.




