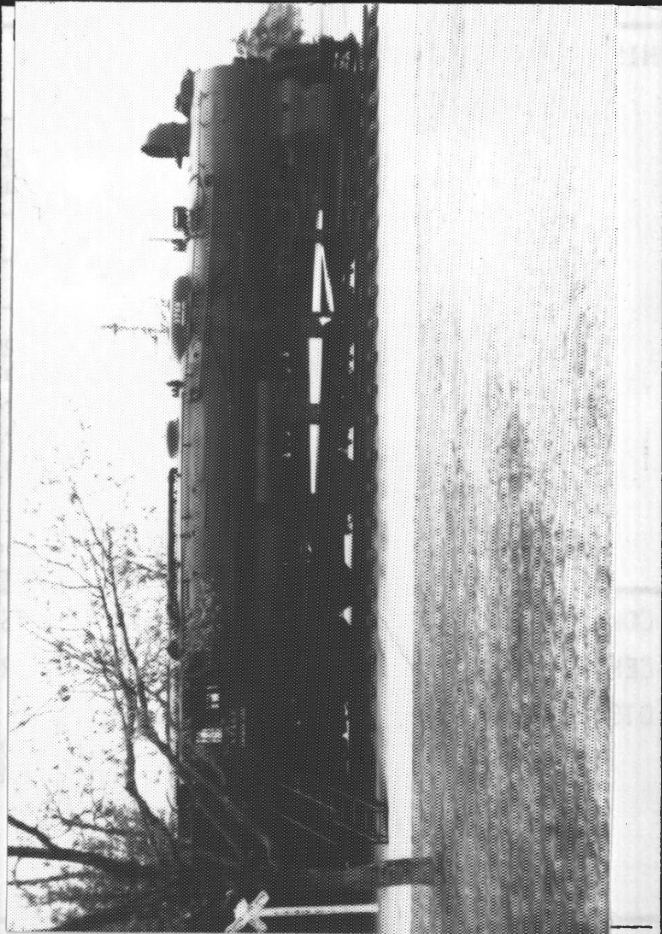

ENGINEERING/STRUCTURAL Mountain type coal-burning steam locomotive converted to oil.

DISTRICT/STREETSCAPE CONTRIBUTION Located in a city park along main thoroughfare through town. Excellent public attraction.

DISCUSS AS REQUIRED: Presented to Kingman in 1957 by S.F. Railway Co. Traveled 2,585,600 miles. Final steam run in 1953. Top speed 100 mph.

Made 10 passenger round trips monthly between Los Angeles and Alubquerque, with Kingman a water stop on the eastbound run. The locomotive was a familiar site to Kingmanites and an integral part of the city's commercial life.
