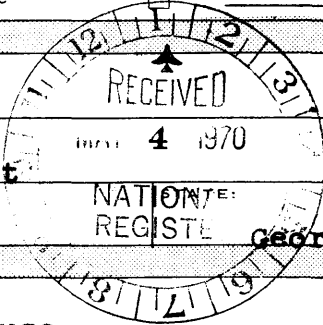

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Cater House is a two and one-half story Plantation Style house with a Classic portico supported by 4 two story square columns and a free standing second story porch. All windows are 16/16 throughout the entire house, many of which still have the original glass. The first floor front windows have elaborate semi-circular caps, with three magnolia leaves. The entrance is a single, panelled door with sidelights and fixed transom. The front facade is flush siding, with engaged corner pilasters. The remainder of the house is clapboard. The cornice extends around the entire house and includes dentils and two brackets over each of the four columns. The same detailing is used in the gable, which has a pattee, or form^e, cross in the center.

The house recently underwent restoration, and is in good condition. The interior, most of which is original includes good mantels, doors, wainscoting and other panelling and a fine stairway.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

The Cater House was built c.1833 for Hardy Bryan, one of the earlier settlers of Thomasville and a Trustee of Thomasville Academy. Bryan died in 1859 and the house was sold to G.M.Branner in 1865 and to Major Moses W.Linton in 1872. The Cater House is an excellent example of the early 19th century Plantation house, and retains almost all of its original interior and exterior detailing.

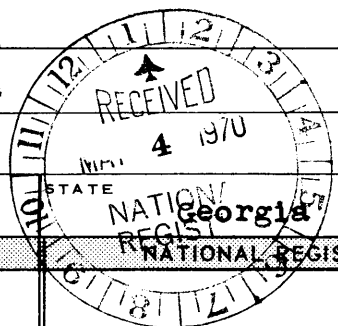

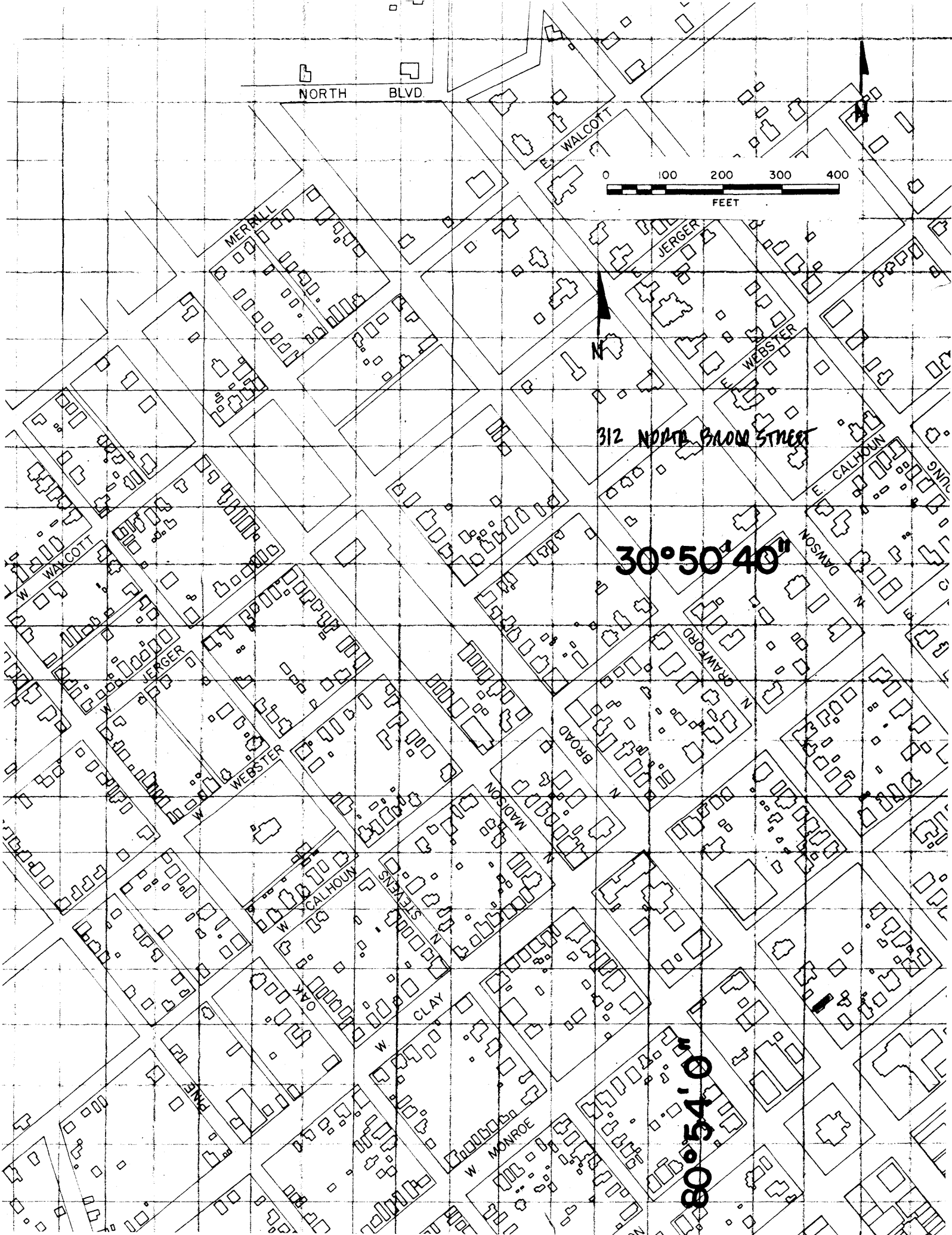
