


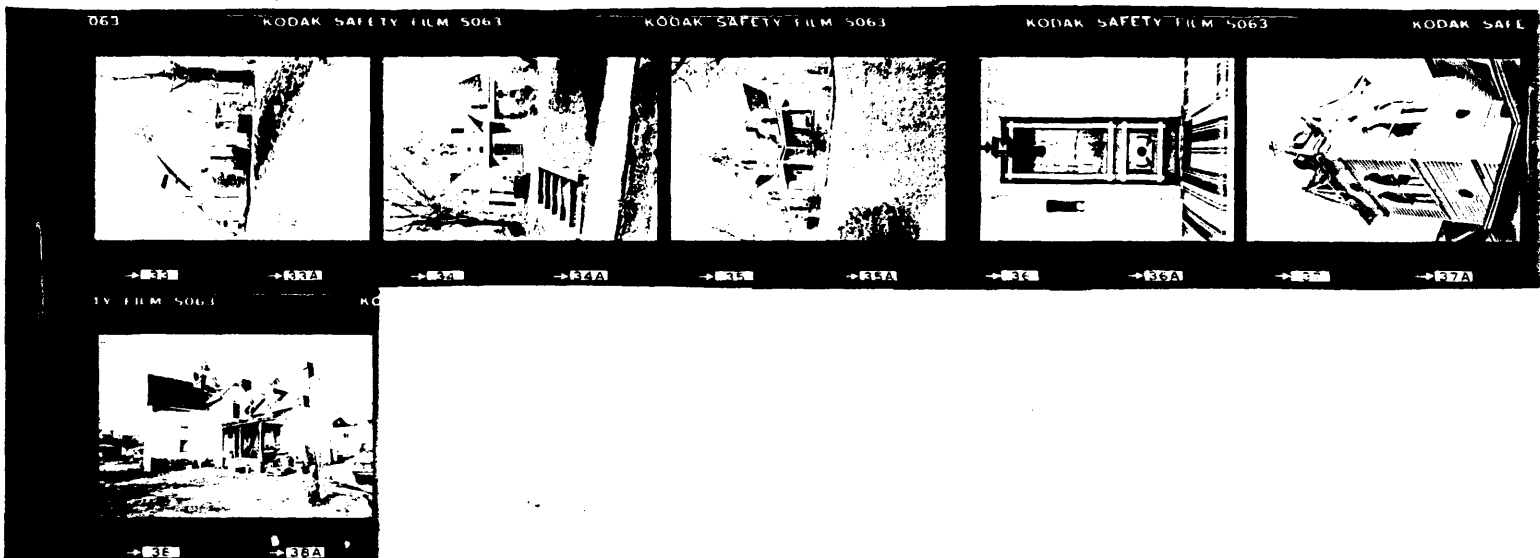

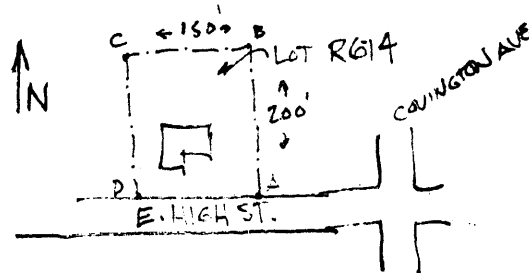

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage less than an acre

The boundaries were chosen to correspond to town lot R6-14. Beginning at point A on the north side of High Street, proceeding north 200' to point B, thence west 150' to point C, thence south 200' to point D, thence east 150 feet to the point of origin. The boundaries were chosen to include the house and its immediate domestic-related space. The property includes one contributing and no noncontributing buildings.
