later a rooming/care facility. The house is now in a deteriorated to fair condition. The only ancillary building to survive is a square, wood frame, one and a half story carriage barn located at the rear of the main dwelling. The barn was stuccoed and converted into a year-round residence in 1952. A one story, cement block garage was built in 1967 just northeast of the barn.

The swimming pool, pool house and windmill no longer remain. Remnants of the formal gardens, shrubbery and field stone walls, however, do.

Significance:

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used as an officer quarters during World War II, a nursing home, and a funeral home. For a portion of its existence it has stood vacant. The house is currently being used as a single family residence. The current owner of the summer house intends to restore the home to its former integrity. Its original architectural lines, basic floor plan, and interior space survive intact.

The carriage barn was converted in 1952 to a single family dwelling. The property is now owned separately from the original estate.
