NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The # 2 Farmers Voting House is located on a large flat lot 1/10 mile south of Farmers on Route 801. The Rowan County Fiscal Court obtained the voting house lot from Fenton and W.G. Stevens on November 9, 1915. The Court paid \$300.00 for the lot (Deed Book 8, pp. 570-571). In April 1934 the Fiscal Court ordered the original voting house be vacated, (Book 4 pp. 277). The reason for the order is unknown.

The # 2 voting house is constructed of ashlar cut stone and beaded mortar. Exposed beams project from the standing seam tin roof. One over one windows are placed on the north and south elevations, with three 2' x 2' single lights located under the west gable eave. The windows have ashlar cut stone sills, but lack lintels. The three lights on the west elevation were positioned high to give light and to ensure privacy to citizens voting in three booths located under the windows. Victorian beaded boards seal the gable ends between the stone walls and roofs. A capped yellow brick chimney is located at the center of the roof ridge.

NARRATIVE STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The # 2 Farmers Voting House meets criterion A and is a significant physical representation of the New Deal. It was constructed by the WPA and used exclusively as a voting house during the period of significance. The # 2 Farmers Voting House has retained a majority of the original materials and is recognizable in function as a voting house. The # 2 Farmers Voting House is located in its original setting and location, and has retained its integrity of association as a building constructed by one of the New deal era agencies.
