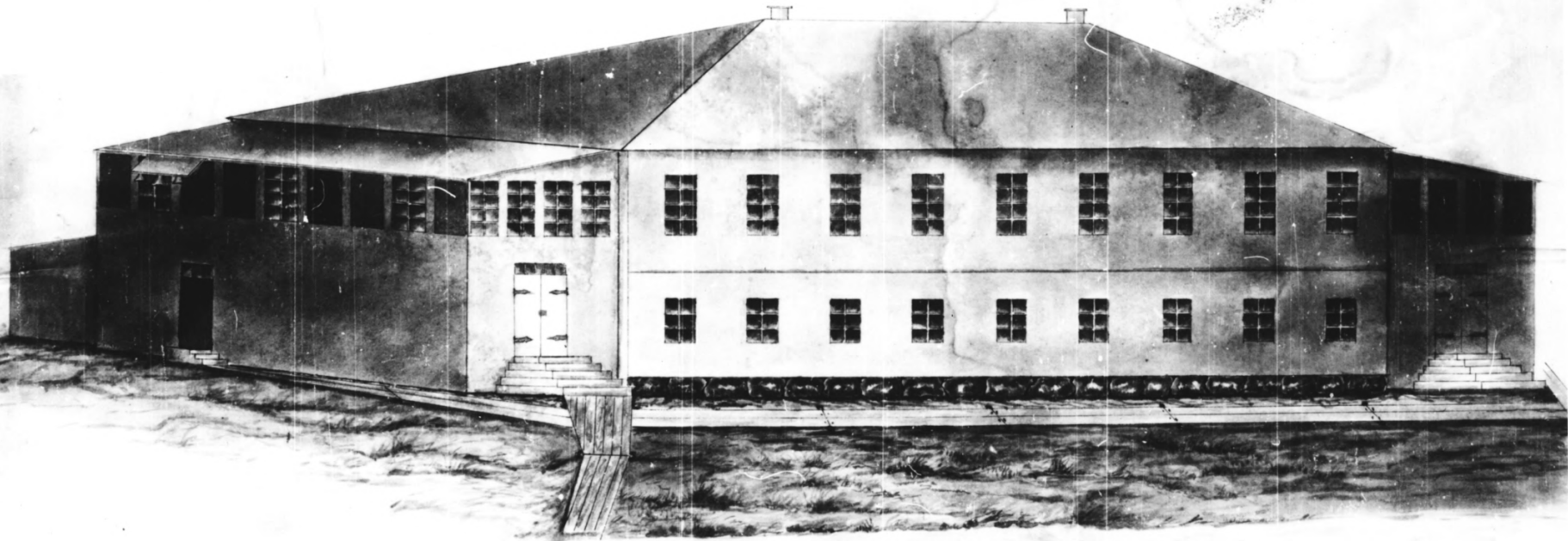


FIGURE #1 SOUTHWEST ELEVATIONAL SKETCH 1842

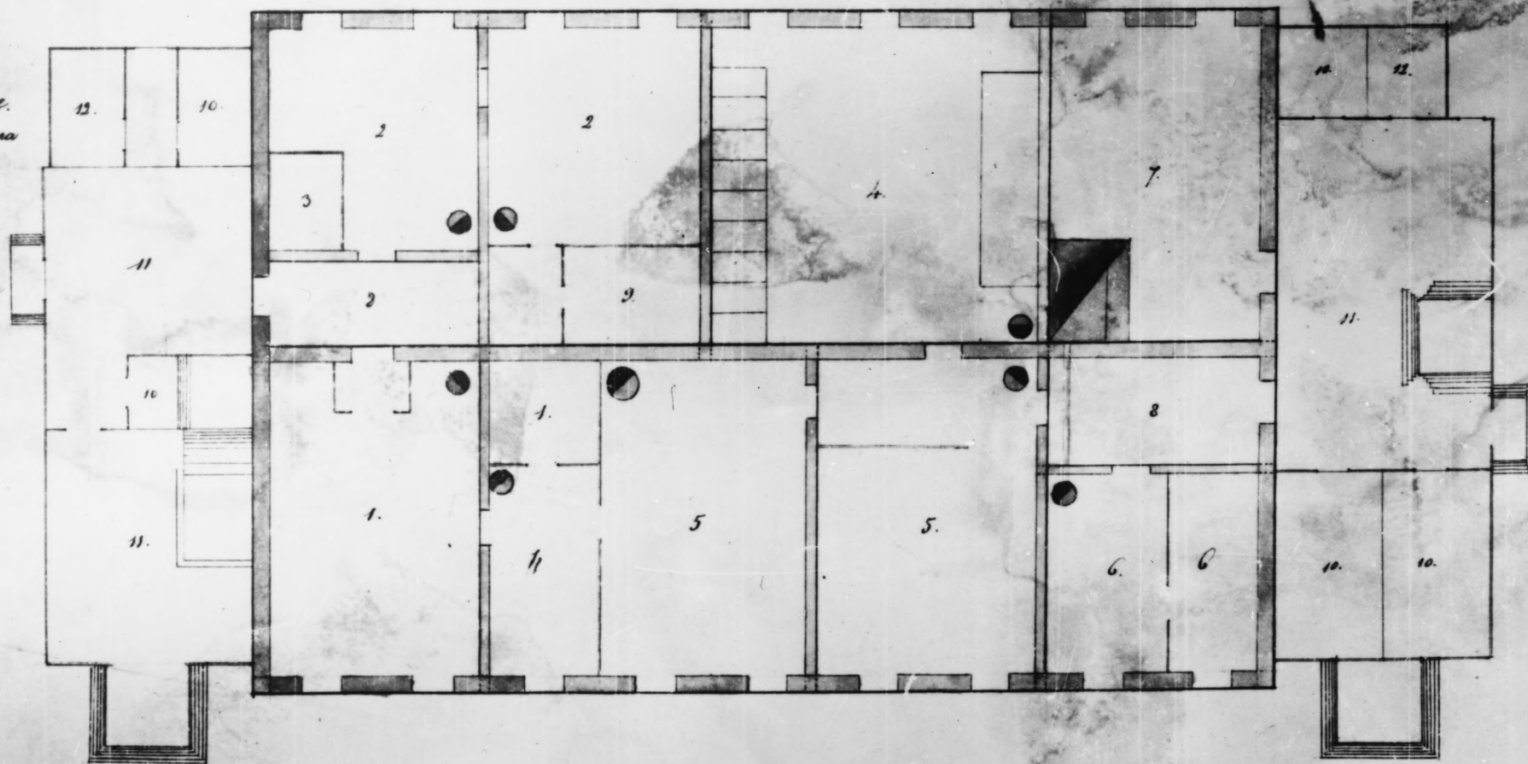
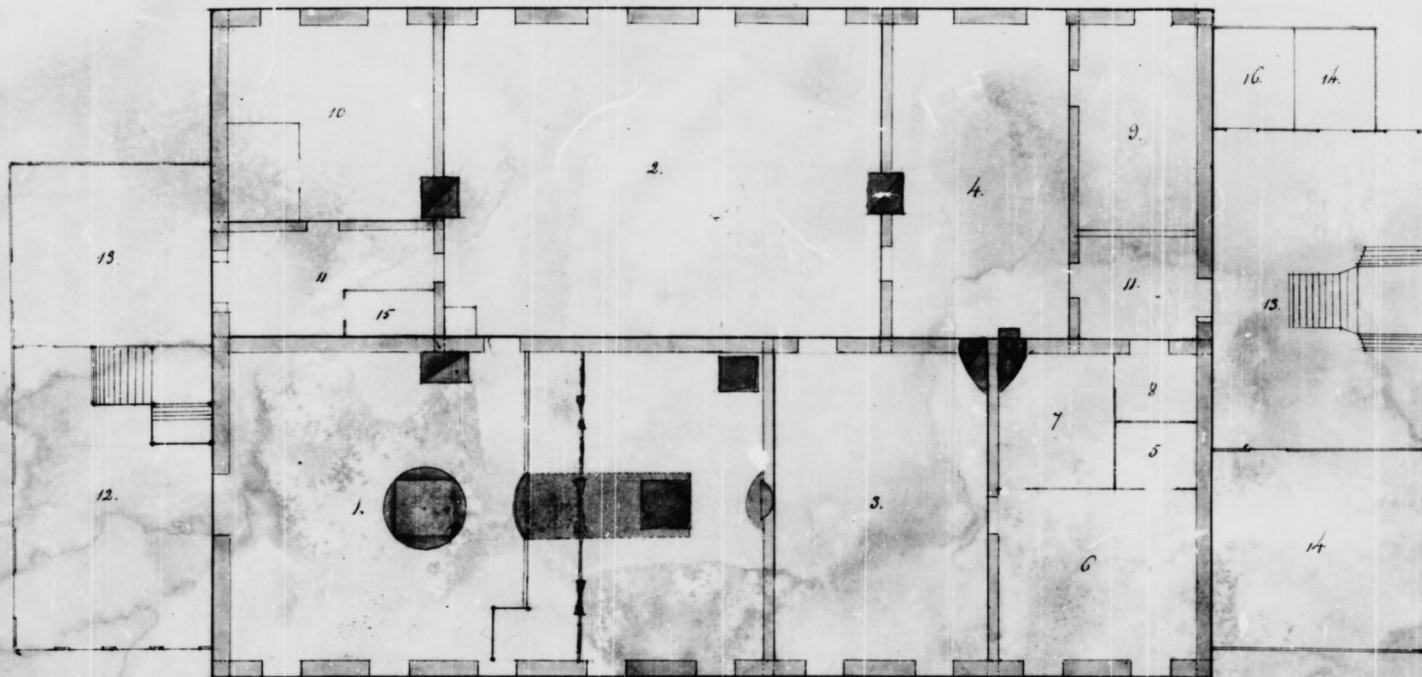


FIGURE #2 . . . FIRST FLOOR PLAN 1842

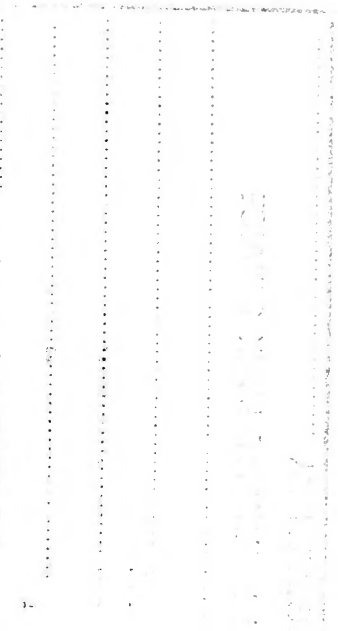
