The Dillingham Transportation Building is architecturally significant as a good example of the Mediterranean revival style applied to a commercial structure. The first story round arched arcade, upper story quoins and the low pitched, tile, hipped roof, well convey the style. The Mediterranean and Spanish mission revival styles enjoyed tremendous popularity in Hawaii during the twenties. These styles, the closest European equivalents to tropical design, were considered to be the most appropriate forms for Hawaii's climate with their arcades providing a sense of airy openness. The Dillingham Transportation Building is one of a number of downtown buildings to employ these styles, and is the most imposing of the Mediterranean revival buildings in the area.

The Dillingham Transportation Building is an integral part of the historic architectural patina of the now highrise-pocked Bishop Street area. Commanding the entire block on Bishop between Queen Street and Nimitz Highway, this building with its moderately formal facade mediates between the more highly embellished Second Renaissance Revival and less ornate Spanish mission revival styles. Free from the more formal restraints of the Beaux-Arts tradition, yet employing Renaissance revival elements in a commanding way, the Dillingham Transportation Building stands as a significant architectural landmark in Honolulu's downtown area. The building harmonizes well with its eclectic neighbors, the Alexander & Baldwin Building, with its excellent adaptation of Oriental and European features, and the Italian Renaissance inspired Alexander Young Hotel, First National Bank and Davies block (which is no longer extant).

The building is also significant for its associations with Benjamin Franklin Dillingham, the founder of Dillingham Corporation, whom the building memorializes. In 1889, after devoting twenty years to the hardware business, B. F. Dillingham created the Oahu Railroad and Land Company. This company was primarily responsible for the development of the 160 mile Oahu Railroad (NR). Through these rail interests, the corporation became involved with the development of the various sugarcane plantations along its route, and later expanded its cane activities to the islands of Kauai, Maui and Hawaii with the McBryde, Kihei, Puna and Olaa Sugar Companies. In 1910, the company received the government contract to dredge Pearl Harbor, which provided the company with a solid financial base. It has greatly expanded upon this base and presently ranks among the major three corporations in the state.
