Esteemed Friend E. G. Faile above I send  
thee a draft on S. Willetts for \$700 per 90 days  
which I wish thee to have lodged in a Bank  
for collection or discounted to take up  
the draft I drew on thee 4<sup>th</sup> 23<sup>rd</sup> in favour  
of A. S. Thompson at 4<sup>th</sup> for \$475.10<sup>00</sup> one of  
my neighbours. S. L. Booth has written to  
Hartford to have some money paid in  
to thee on my acc I wish when he pays  
it to thee thee would write to me and  
inform me how much he has paid on my  
acc so I can settle with Booth. I did intend  
to send a larger draft but have been disap-  
pointed in getting my flour made and  
sent off. I find hard collecting at this  
time and fear it will continue to be  
so as the price of wheat has fallen in  
N.Y. our farmers look for 8<sup>th</sup> but it is  
not worth over 6<sup>th</sup> I wish thee to send me  
1 lb Molasses, 1 lb Coffee, 1 Chest S. H. Tea  
2 lb Macerel No. 2. 2 lb No 2 Macerel
