Built of brick,

The exterior has since been covered with gray stucco. A mezzanine floor was added in 1965 as was a new basement, so the building has three stories. The clock tower that was added in 1888 has a curved mansard roof with the clock faces in gabled dormers. The remainder of the building has a hipped roof with a bracketed cornice. Side elevations have center gabled dormers with paired windows.

The architectural integrity of the interior has been damaged by the addition of accoustical tile and paneling throughout.





SIGNIFICANCE:

This is the oldest courthouse in Georgia still in original use. Its exterior and setting in the center of town on the tree shaded square are features which make it significant.
