The old Central High School was designed in 1892 by Palmer, Ball, and Hunt, Architects, and is one of the state's finest examples of Richardsonian Romanesque architecture. This massive, three-story structure of Lake Superior brown-stone is distinguished by a large and elaborately carved Syrian arch entrance at the base of its central tower which is set between two smaller turretts and rises to a height of nearly 210 feet. The rounded arches of the entrance are repeated in the many rows of windows, in the large stone wall dormers, and on the clock tower, with its huge illuminated glass dials. The building occupies an entire city block, about twenty feet above the street with irregular and oblique stairways leading up to the front entrance. The ground plan of the structure is that of an inverted "T".

The interior of Central High School was very progressive for its time. The basement housed the motive power and utility rooms, mechanical arts room and the ventilating and heating systems.

The first floor consisted of eleven 30'x33' classrooms; the offices of the Board of Education; and the library, a handsome room with a large brownstone fireplace. Large double stairways constructed of slate and iron led to the upper floors.

On the second floor were ten large classrooms. The 72'x104', two story auditorium retains its wood paneling of the wainscot, the balcony and the window frames. The decorative bands of carved wood, the bracketed cornice, and the crossbeamed ceiling also remain intact.

The laboratories, drafting room, gymnasium, music room, and manual training departments, including iron and woodworking; were located on the third floor. A museum containing collections of birds, mammals, reptiles, minerals and curios was located in the west wing.

Except for the auditorium and a few classrooms on the third floor which remain in near original condition, the interior of Central School has been greatly altered. The slate stairways were moved and enclosed within the ends of the main longitudinal hall was in order to add more classrooms and comply with fire regulations.

The second street facade remains as designed, except for the closing of the three arched doorways which were used as the Form 10-300a (July 1969)

Central High was designed by Emmet S. Palmer, Lucien Hall, and Richard M. Hunt, very able eastern architects, the latter being the first American trained at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris. The local architects were Oliver Traphagen and Francis Fitzpatric.

Old Central is a very fine example of that traditionally rich architectural style known as Romanesque, and is certainly the most outstanding structure of its kind to be found in northern Minnesota. The facade and tower present a totally pleasing design with exceptionally beautiful proportion and line. The vertical fenestration and tower are exceptionally well studied wherein particular consideration was taken due to the fact that the viewer would at all times be standing considerably below the building, resulting in a foreshortening of the verticals. Expert attention was also paid to the scale of the building. This was perfected in part through belt coursing and rustication of the beautiful stonework. The building, too, is skillfully sited on a full city block of hillside property of considerable slope.

Old Central with its imposing clock tower has long been a Duluth landmark. Its architectural merit and sound structural condition make it a worthy candidate for preservation and inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.




