DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Allis house stands on the northwest corner of East Royall Place and North Prospect Avenue on Milwaukee's near east side. Traditional in style--its design was inspired by Tudor prototypes--it is traditional, too, in terms of the visible building materials--brick, sandstone, marble, mahogany, walnut, bronze, leaded glass. But it is said that steel and concrete were also employed in its construction, for the original owner intended from the outset that in due course his home would become a public building. And so it did on the death of his widow twenty-nine years ago. The house now belongs to the City of Milwaukee and is operated, under the aegis of the Milwaukee Public Library System, as a public museum, housing the splendid collection of paintings, graphics, small sculpture, and decorative arts assembled by Charles Allis and his wife.

The Allis house is a rectangular building two and one-half stories in height, with walls of mauve-brown Ohio brick trimmed with Lake Superior sandstone of a similar but lighter hue. Steeply pitched intersecting gabled roofs crown the composition. Facade (south elevation) and first floor plan are symmetrical. A small entrance foyer on the south opens into the main hall, which has marble flooring, marble-panelled walls, and an arched ceiling with elaborate plaster ornament. To the west are the dining room, kitchen, and pantry; to the east are the living room and library, the latter opening onto a small porch that occupies that northeast corner of the first floor. Dining room and library are panelled with Honduras mahogany; the living room woodwork is Circassian walnut. All three rooms retain their original furnishings. A marble staircase with bronze balusters and mahogany stair rail joins the main hall and second floor. Rooms and corridors on the upper story are also used to exhibit the Allis collection as well as changing displays of other collections and work by regional artists.

Adjoining the west side of the house is a one and one-half story wing that served originally as the garage and has been remodelled for use as a meeting and lecture room. There have been no other major alterations to interior or exterior, and building and grounds are well-maintained.

Designated as a Milwaukee Landmark in 1972, this elegant building was designed by the distinguished local architect Alexander C. Eschweiler for Charles Allis, first president of the Allis-Chalmers Manufacturing Company. After the death of Sarah Ball Allis in 1945, ownership of the mansion and its contents--a fine collection of art objects and furnishings --passed to the City of Milwaukee, and the residence became a museum, operated as the Charles Allis Art Library by the Milwaukee Public Library System. It survives in an excellent state of preservation. The Allis collection includes oriental porcelains, ceramics, and carvings; small bronzes dating from the Renaissance era and the 19th century; graphics by Albrecht Dürer, Rembrandt, and James A. M. Whistler--among others; 18th century French furniture; and landscapes by Thomas Gainsborough, Winslow Homer, C. F. Daubigny, J. B. C. Corot, and others.

A son of E. P. Allis, founder of the important Edward P. Allis & Company in Milwaukee, Charles Allis became a prominent Milwaukee industrialist and financier and served as secretary-treasurer of the company after his father's death in 1889. He was president of the newly formed Allis-Chalmers Company (1901-1905), vice-president and director of the Milwaukee Trust Company, director of the First National Bank, trustee of the Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, and organizer and president of the Chicago Belting Company. Charles Allis took a deep interest in art and was the first president of the Milwaukee Art Society and a trustee of the Layton Art Gallery. (Excerpted from the Dictionary of Wisconsin Biography).
