

The nominated property occupies city lots 63 and 66 and is roughly 130' x 110' in size. The boundary includes the entire city lots that have historically been associated with the property.

45. Description and House Plan:

In its original state, the Petersburg Christian Church was a distinguished example of local traditional church architecture in the Greek Revival style. Its character was derived chiefly from the gable-front: three bays marked by raised pilasters, a dualleaf central door flanked by recessed brick panels. The sides were given five window bays, each window, now 2/2 pane sash, topped with a stone lintel.

Stylistic modifications to the building made in the 1870s included grouped brackets at the eaves, a decorative gable-peak of Gothic origins, and a louvered bell tower with pilasters on all four faces and a concave-pyramidal roof.

Twentieth century additions extending from the rear of the church have not appreciably disturbed the historical feeling of the church.

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
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
